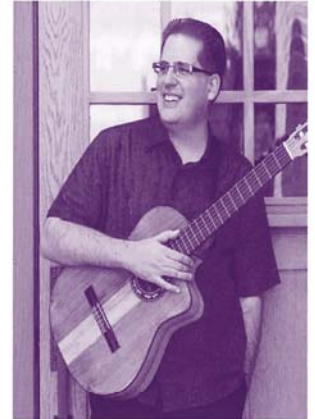

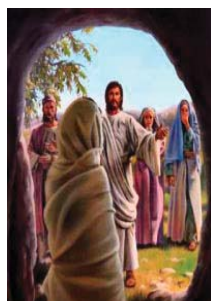

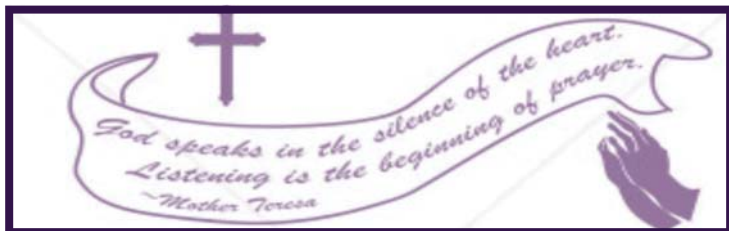

EL PECADO Y LA PENITENCIA

Entramos a la semana santa. Hoy hemos reflexionado sobre el salmo 50 , el pecador arrepentido, salmo que debemos reflexionar bastante durante este tiempo y aprender del arrepentimiento y del perdón de Dios. Pidamos todos, "Oh Dios crea en mi un corazón Puro renuévame por dentro con espíritu firme. Devuélveme la alegría de la salvación

En los tiempos modernos el debate sobre el pecado ha sido muy importante. Ahora que terminamos con el Quinto Domingo de Cuaresma este ciclo para entrar después en la Semana Santa debemos saber si el tiempo fuerte de Cuaresma ha servido para la purificación del espíritu, el perdón de los pecados y el uso alegre del Sacramento de la Penitencia, aún estamos a tiempo de recibir la reconciliación con Dios con otros y nosotros mismos.

Hay muchas opiniones acerca del pecado, el perdón, el arrepentimiento etc, pero nosotros debemos contemplar nuestra realidad como creyentes católicos, hay remordimientos por nuestras malas acciones, contra otros, nosotros y la sociedad. Sin embargo todos tenemos algo bueno que ofrecer siempre, estamos llamados al bien. El sacramento de la penitencia o reconciliación nos regenera, nos sana, limpia nuestras heridas, no lo debemos sustituir por otras prácticas, modernas o psicológicas, porque el sacramento es uno el del Perdón de Dios sobre nosotros.

La Confesión pone a la persona frente a Dios, con la intermediación discreta del sacerdote. Nuestros males – y pecados—suponen en la mayoría de los casos un distanciamiento de la doctrina principal dada por Jesucristo. "Amarás a Dios sobre todas las cosas y al prójimo como a ti mismo" Y es que la mayoría de nuestros pecados son daños hechos a nuestros hermanos cuando nos olvidamos de Dios. Llama la atención que en relato evangélico del Juicio Final, Cristo pregunta --preguntará-- por los actos buenos y malos realizados con y contra El en los hermanos. Dar de comer, de beber, abrigo, visitas, etc. Es esa mala relación entre nosotros, Dios y los hermanos lo que produce el pecado. Ahí aparecen la violencia, la explotación, el culto al dinero, etc.

Parece, entonces, que queda en una esquina lejana otro tipo de pecados que son los relativos al sexo y suelen ser muy frecuentes. Hay, asimismo, una tendencia a disculparlos. Pero es un absurdo. En la prostitución, en la promiscuidad, en la pornografía hay fundamentalmente mucho de esos males violentos contra el prójimo y contra uno mismo. El sexo se desboca y hace mucho mal. Los adulterios rompen las familias y en muchos casos en el inicio de una crisis de esa naturaleza se ha iniciado por una aventura galante sin aparente importancia. El pecado es siempre igual. Es siempre lo mismo: la lejanía de Dios y el daño a los hermanos. Hay -claro- muchas formas de llevarlo a cabo. No debemos olvidar que hay pecado en nosotros. En estos días debemos volver a Dios. El premio inmediato es una paz que habla de Dios y ama. Y resulta necesario que en este umbral del próximo inicio de los sublimes misterios de la Semana Santa nuestras almas se purifiquen del pecado. Reflexionemos en estos días que nos quedan hasta el Domingo de Ramos sobre nuestras carencias y faltas.

No nos dejemos llevar por doctrinas que llevan a la muerte de la vida de fe, seamos humildes y reconozcamos nuestras faltas y pecados y vayamos con amor a recibir el perdón de Dios y el nuestro. Que así sea amén. Paz y Bien.

la Pascua. Las flores serán un recordatorio para todos nosotros.





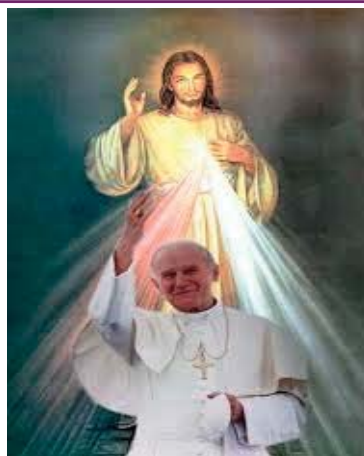

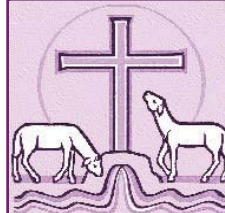
