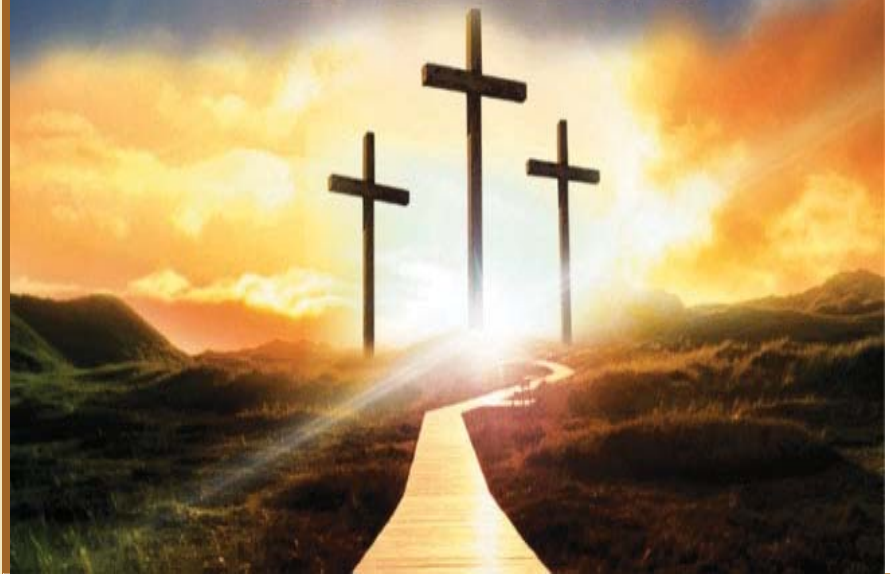

Easter Novena

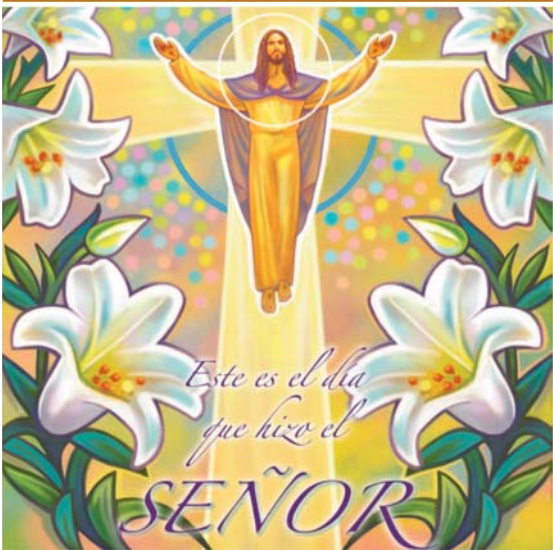

CRISTO HA RESUCITADO Y NOSOTROS INVITADOS A RESUCITAR DIARIAMENTE.

De Jesús se dice, " PASÓ HACIENDO EL BIEN.- "... a Jesús de Nazaret, ungido por Dios con la fuerza del Espíritu Santo..." (Hch 10, 38) La unción y el poder son propios del Rey de Israel. Jesús es por ello el nuevo Rey de la casa de David. Los reyes anteriores a Él habían recibido una unción efímera, un óleo caduco y carente de poder. Reyes que iban sucediéndose unos a otros sin más trascendencia. Hombres débiles, víctimas de intrigas y pasiones, con un final trágico o feliz, pero siempre sepultados en la historia y en el olvido.

En Jesús la unción ha sido diversa y el final muy distinto. Cuando todo parecía haber terminado, entonces era cuando todo empezaba. Los apóstoles pensaron que la cruz, la muerte vergonzosa en el madero, era el final. Les parecía que el telón había caído de modo definitivo, borrando para siempre el nombre de Jesús sobre la tie-

rra. Pero no era así, el telón se ha rasgado para no bajar ni subir más. Y al descubierto ha dejado, envuelto en un, el vencedor de la invencible muerte, exaltado sobre toda la creación, dueño y Señor del universo. Rey de reyes, alfa y omega, principio y fin. Jesucristo ayer y hoy y para siempre.

Jesús paso por esta vida, hizo el bien, " (Hch 10, 38). Jesús pasó por nuestros polvorientos caminos. Y su paso llenó de paz y de alegría nuestros paisajes. Una primavera eterna se inicia con Él y tiñe de verdor y fragancia nuestros campos. La muerte y el pecado habían ensombrecido el horizonte del hombre, sembrando en su corazón la angustia y el temor, la incertidumbre ante el más allá. Nos llenaba de zozobra la idea de un final definitivo, el hundirnos en las sombras y el silencio para siempre. Nos dolía la separación de nuestros seres queridos. Sufríamos al pensar que todo terminaba en una fosa, quedando sólo la espera muda y fría de un cuerpo muerto comido de gordos gusanos.

Sin embargo, después del triunfo de Jesucristo, la vida de un cristiano no es así. Para el que cree en Cristo la muerte no es más que un mal sueño, una pesadilla, unas lágrimas y suspiros, quizás, que dan paso a la esperanza y a la paz... Jesús ha resucitado, y con Él resucitaremos todos. Así es. Si no lo fuera, nuestra fe sería algo vacío, nuestra vida tremendamente desgraciada, algo sin sentido. Pero no, Cristo ha resucitado y ha sido ensalzado hasta la diestra del Padre, donde está para interceder por nosotros. Por eso hay que alegrarse hasta cantar de gozo en este tiempo pascual, dejar cauce libre a la alegría que estalla en mil aleluyas porque Jesucristo ha instaurado el Reino de la Vida.

ESTE ES EL DÍA.- "Dad gracias al Señor..." (Sal 118, 1). Tanto hemos recibido, tanta comprensión y tanto cariño nos ha mostrado que bien podemos afirmar sin la menor duda que es bueno, que eterna es su misericordia hacia esta nuestra "eterna" debilidad y malicia.

"La diestra del Señor es poderosa -dice el salmo de hoy-, la diestra del Señor es excelsa. No he de morir, viviré para cantar las hazañas del Señor... Y así, aunque el peso de nuestros pecados nos llene de pesar y de temor, tengamos una gran fe en Jesús que ha triunfado, y nos hace triunfar a nosotros, sobre la muerte y sobre el pecado.

Cristo ha resucitado. Y nosotros, los que creemos en Él y le amamos, también hemos resucitado. Hemos despertado del sueño de la muerte que es la vida humana, hemos comenzado, aunque parcialmente aún, la grandiosa aventura de vivir la vida misma de Dios, la vida que dura siempre. Y por eso hemos de vivir proyectados hacia lo alto, pisando en la tierra, pero aspirando a las cumbres del cielo. FELICES PASCUAS DE RESURRECCION.

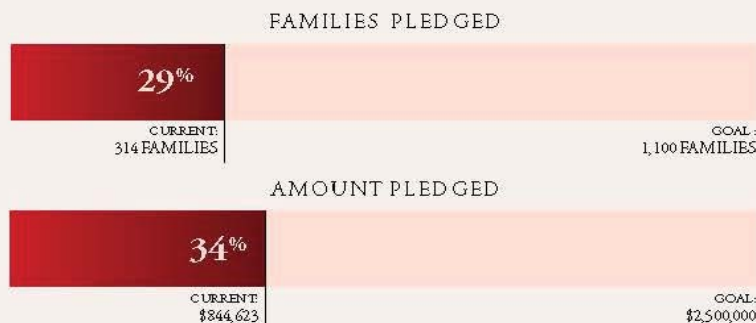

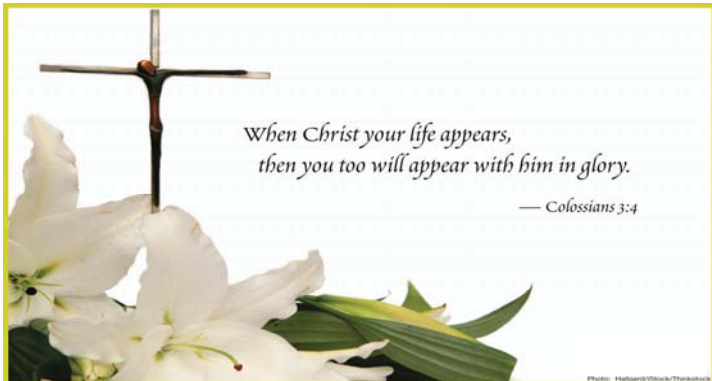
