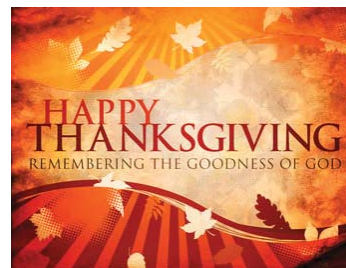

Después de hablar sobre nuestra Campaña Capital en todas las Misas hace unas semanas, recibí dos donaciones, cada una de \$5, de dos alumnos de nuestra escuela. Una nota con las donaciones dice: "Quiero un laboratorio de ciencias". ¡Esas donaciones pequeñas fueron muy grandes para mí! Las donaciones de estos dos estudiantes, y las palabras que escribieron, me hacen darme cuenta de que cada año que demoramos la construcción no solo aumenta el costo de nuestro proyecto y erosiona nuestro entusiasmo y creencia, sino que también hace que nuestros niños esperen. Cada año que pasa sin que comencemos, es otro año en que nuestros hijos se quedarán sin las instalaciones escolares que los alentarán y les mostrarán que son importantes para nosotros, y otro año que nuestras familias de la iglesia continuarán teniendo poco espacio para sus ministerios y sentirse bienvenidos.

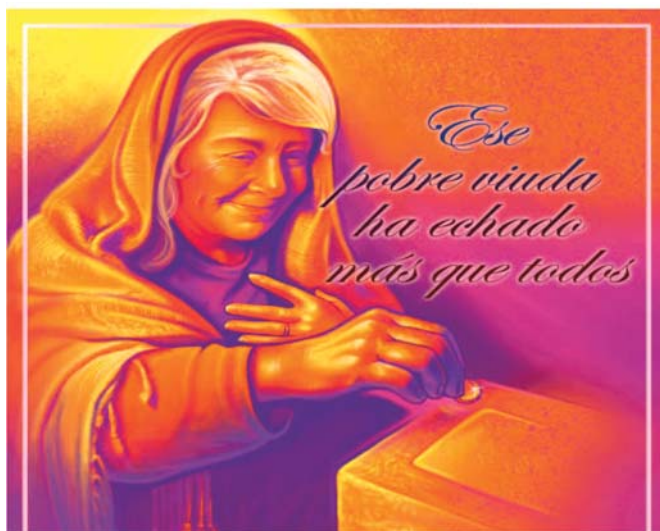
El arquitecto y el director de obra están programados para obtener los permisos, las aprobaciones y el diseño necesarios para comenzar la construcción el 15 de junio de 2019. Sin embargo, estos permisos y diseños se quedarán en pausa si no tenemos suficientes promesas y fondos para comenzar. En febrero, la Arquidiócesis revisará el progreso de nuestra recaudación de fondos. Para recibir la aprobación final para comenzar este verano, debemos recaudar \$ 1.2 millones más en compromisos (en los próximos cinco años) y \$ 465,000 en efectivo.

¡Trabajemos todos juntos para comenzar este verano! Hagámoslo por nosotros mismos, hagámoslo por nuestros hijos, hagámoslo como un buen comienzo de un mayor crecimiento tanto para nuestra escuela como para nuestra iglesia, ya que ambos obtendrán un espacio muy necesario para este proyecto. La finalización de este proyecto nos liberará para continuar trabajando juntos en la construcción de la Iglesia, el Pueblo de Dios.

¿Ayudaras? Nuestro objetivo es que cada persona o familia se comprometa. Si aún no se ha comprometido, le pido que recoja una tarjeta de compromiso de la iglesia o se conecte en línea para comprometerse. 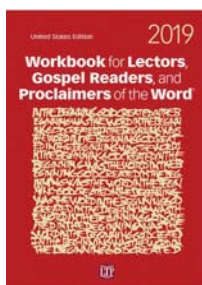
*"Here rests in glory, an American Soldier known but to God."* Inscription on the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier
