Anointing of the Sick



On July 31, 2002, in the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe, our Holy Father canonized Juan Diego Cuauhtlatoatzin. On 9 December 1531, when Juan Diego was on his way to morning Mass, the Blessed Mother appeared to him on Tepeyac Hill, the outskirts of what is now Mexico City. She asked him to go to the Bishop and to request in her name that a shrine be built

at Tepayac, where she promised to pour out her grace upon those who invoked her. The Bishop, who did not believe Juan Diego, asked for a sign to prove that the apparition was true. On December 12, Juan Diego returned to Tepeyac. Here, the Blessed Mother told him to climb the hill and to pick the flowers that he would find in bloom. He obeyed, and although it was winter time, he found roses flowering. He gathered the flowers and took them to Our Lady who carefully placed them in his mantle and told him to take them to the Bishop as proof. When he opened his mantle, the flowers fell on the ground and there remained impressed, in place of the flowers, an image of the Blessed Mother, the apparition at Tepeyac. With the Bishop's permission, Juan Diego lived the rest of his life as a hermit in a small hut near the chapel where the miraculous image was placed for veneration. Here he cared for the church and the first pilgrims who came to pray to the Mother of Jesus. Much deeper than the exterior grace of having been chosen as Our Lady's messenger, Juan Diego received the grace of interior enlightenment and from that moment he began a life dedicated to prayer and the practice of virtue and boundless love of God and neighbor. He died in 1548 and was buried in the first chapel dedicated to the Virgin of Guadalupe. The Church in the Americas celebrates St. Juan Diego annually on December 9th.



The Second Sunday of Advent

The normal response to a surprise is amazement, gratitude, and delight. By definition, we don't anticipate surprises. Their occurrence reminds us that we cannot always guess or shape the future. Granted, we do what we can do; we attend to the daily tasks, as we must. For grace is surely here in the mundane, and God is in the details. But God is in the happy surprises, too.

Today's readings are filled with startling developments. We hear the clarion cry of one of those rare prophets announcing the coming of the Lord. Isaiah proclaims startling, surprising images of the nearly impossible reconciliation of opposites: calf and lion, leopard and young goat, child and serpent. Isaiah's vision sees all of these creatures living in harmony. This is Eden again; this is paradise. It is God's surprise and promise.

John the Baptist's cry reaches out to us on this Second Sunday of Advent: "Prepare the way of the Lord." How do we recognize the way of the Lord? Isaiah gives us a glimpse of this way. When this reading is proclaimed at Mass today, allow the richness of its imagery to transport you to God's holy mountain, where we catch sight of the way of the Lord. This reading is the very definition of the way of peace and justice that is the kingdom of God. Once again, we must express our sadness and lament the fact that our weary world seems to be so far from the way of the Lord. Justice is not something that floats "out there," waiting for some prophetic types to address it. Injustice occurs in our families, in our companies, in our churches, and in our relationships. Let today's scriptures inspire us to recognize the injustice that surrounds us and to do something to address it. Come, Emmanuel!

Youth Night "Fr Masseo, El Padrecito Ministries, and Our Lady"


Open to All Ages, Sunday December 9, 7:30pm – 9:00pm, OLG Parish Hall

Father Masseo Gonzales, OFM Conv, also known as “El Padrecito” from the popular toy HOMIES line, will be speaking to our youth and all “young at heart” after the evening Mass on Sunday, December 9. Inspired and moved by the spirituality and theology of Saint Maximilian Kolbe, he will be addressing the Holy Spirit, Our Blessed Mother, and the Blessed Sacrament, and what it means to be both “saint and sinner” at the same time. A few members his Catholic hip-hop group, FoundNation Family, will also be present to provide some entertainment. All are welcome! About Fr Masseo: As a teen-ager, growing up in the rough streets of Richmond, California, he acquired a police record, was expelled from high school, and lost a portion of his right leg at nineteen as a result of a street fight. It was only after this traumatic event that he returned back to his childhood faith – Catholicism. He was inspired by the Franciscans taking over his parish in San Pablo, Ca. in 1985, joined them, and was ordained a Priest in 1996.

Though he has worked at many parishes, including teaching at Bishop Montgomery High School (1996-2000), he soon knew he had a “vocation within a vocation” to work with youth, and started his own non-profit 501c3 ministry 2006, El Padrecito Ministries.

He has traveled, spoken and performed around the United States, along with his Catholic hip-hop group, FoundNation Family, along with performing at World Youth Day in Brazil in 2013.

He, along with FoundNation, will also be performing at World Youth Day in Panama come January of 2019. A second collection will be taking place at all the Masses at Our Lady of Guadalupe (Hermosa Beach) on the weekend of December 8th and 9th, to support this endeavor.


Christmas Flowers


