ALEGRÍA Y LIMPIEZA DE CORAZÓN

Hoy celebramos el tercer domingo de adviento, que llamamos Gaudete, regocíjate o alegría, significa que la esperanza está mucho más cerca, más certera en nosotros. La alegría no es un elemento muy frecuente en nuestra época. Tal vez, la tristeza, tampoco. Mucha gente vive en un estado intermedio, más o menos, fría, inexpresiva. Los sentimientos parecen cada vez más amortiguados en nuestra sociedad y a cambio de ellos sólo hay deseos: de riqueza, de poder, de tener más cosas, de poseer sexualmente más que de amar. Muchos que quieren exhibir un poco de alegría tienen que tomarse unas copitas y, entonces, viven una cierta euforia alegre, que llegado el bajón se convierte en algo sin sentido, en frialdad, en frustración. Y es que, a veces, la tristeza es un mecanismo de superación. Un estado que nos conduce a la alegría una vez superada. Una cierta melancolía triste es algo. No es que todos estén tristes o sea todo negativo, no, gracias a Dios que no es así, pero es muy común que en este tiempo se acentúen las dificultades, especialmente las emocionales, por eso el adviento en sus domingos anteriores nos habla de la esperanza, de la fe, de algo nuevo que vendrá y que esta entre nosotros. Y siempre la cercanía del Señor en su Primera Venida, en el milagro portentoso de Belén, es un camino de alegría porque todo ello está rodeado de paz y de novedad.

El mensaje es estén siempre alegres en el Señor; se los repito: estén alegres. El Señor está cerca”. La alegría es un síntoma indeleble de la conversión, de la cercanía evidente de Dios. Nadie que haya conocido al Señor —y haya perseverado— puede estar triste. Hemos oído muchas veces, la famosa frase: “un santo triste es un triste santo”. Y así es. Si la tristeza perdura en nuestros corazones es porque no hemos recibido al Señor. No hemos aceptado su llegada. Es verdad que la vida nos puede traer hechos malos y complicados que dispongan el ánimo a la tristeza, pero por encima de ellos, está la alegría que Dios comunica a los que le aman. Ese canto a la alegría está precisamente en el fragmento de la Carta que Pablo dirigía a los fieles de Filipenses. De hecho toda la epístola a los Filipenses en una sinfonía alegre motivada por la espera ante la Llegada del Señor. Es posible, de todos modos, que convenga terminar con el diagnóstico sobre la tristeza: quien no es limpio de corazón, quien tiene muchos recovecos de odio, de impureza, de desconfianza, de envidia, en su interior, no puede estar alegre.

El Salmo de hoy es muy particular. Y lo es porque no es un Salmo, sino unos versos sacados del capítulo 12 del Libro de Isaías. En ese texto se nos pide alegría y júbilo porque Dios está con nosotros. Y si se dan cuenta unas partes breves de la liturgia de hoy nos han marcado el camino. Siempre hemos de apercibirnos de la sabiduría, incluida en los textos —en todos ellos, grandes y pequeños— que leemos cada domingo. Y apreciar la especial inteligencia de quienes, hace muchos años, pusieron las bases de la celebración del Día del Señor. Asimismo, nuestra primera lectura tiene unas características especiales. Procede del Libro del Profeta Sofonías. Y en general su relato es muy triste, porque Israel está viviendo muy malos momentos. Los reyes de Israel no defienden lo fundamental y los invasores asirios están muy cerca. Pero, en un momento, se hace un rayo de luz en tanta oscuridad. El Rey Josías se anuncia como un gran reformador y la presión de los ejércitos de Asiria parece que se desvanece. Se espera una nueva etapa y eso produce que el profeta triste exalte de alegría para anunciar un gran gozo. Es como nos ocurre a nosotros. En medio de nuestras dificultades cotidianas está la alegría de la llegada del Señor Jesús, que hará nuestra vida mejor, que cambiará nuestro mundo de injusticia en un mundo de paz y amor.

Today has traditionally been called Gaudete Sunday. The Latin tag is derived from Paul's appeal in the second reading to rejoice always in the Lord, and the Latin Mass text based on that reading. The irony and paradox of this Christian joy is underlined by the fact that Paul wrote those words in prison. But from there he

could see the progress of God's work. Is it obvious to us? We feel that this is not the time for joy when there is so much suffering and moral evil. It is interesting, then, that the first reading is from the prophet Zephaniah, who is almost exclusively concerned with gloomy visions of Judgment Day. Today the Church selects the only optimistic text in Zephaniah, in which the prophet has been touched by the spirit of joy.

This, we are assured on all sides, is the season of joy. Let us recapture that feeling of joy in our lives and reflect it to those who are joyless.

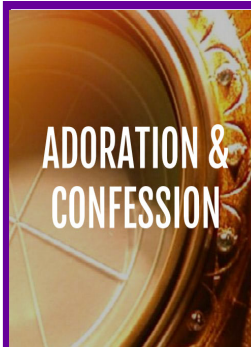

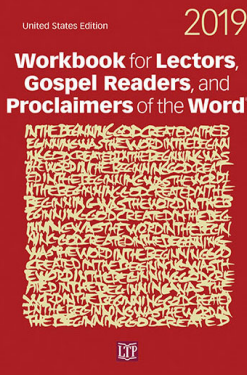

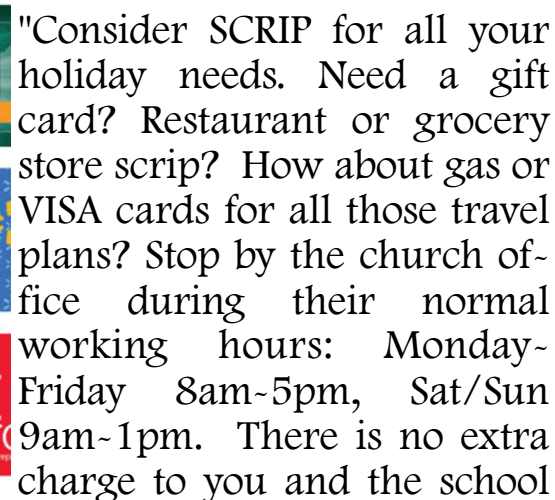
