

contaban las mujeres. Donde esperaban ver un cuerpo sin vida han encontrado un sepulcro vacío. La vida ha vencido a la muerte. Cristo ya no está entre los muertos, ha resucitado y está vivo y presente en medio de nosotros. La tumba vacía es signo de la Resurrección. Pedro, es el primero en entrar en el sepulcro. Ún reino de luz y de vida, como hemos rezado en la oración colecta de la misa de hoy.
