### *An Update on our Capital Campaign*

Greetings and Peace. Our “Building our Faith” campaign continues as the design for the addition to our church and school; to add office space and conference rooms to the school (allowing the current school offices to be converted into a dedicated ministry space), a Science Technology Engineering and Mathematics (S.T.E.M.) lab, a general purpose music and arts room, and outdoor gathering space adjacent to the church entrance, awaits final permits from the city of Hermosa Beach. We expect the construction documents to be approved any day now. The next step in this process is to meet with the Financial Services Department of the Archdiocese of Los Angeles to receive a loan to cover the cost of the project we have yet to raise. To date we have raised over \$2.6 Million in cash and pledges. Now that the design is complete, we have been able to get accurate pricing. We have sent the drawings out to three contractors for competitive bid and have worked with the contractors to reduce cost as much as possible. The current cost of the project is \$3.8 Million. This is larger than the \$3.0 Million we have been using as our fundraising goal. The main reasons for this increase are two; costs

have increased since the estimate of nearly two years ago, and the engineering analysis of our soil after drilling has determined that a larger foundation than anticipated is required. To cover this larger cost, when we meet with the Archdiocese asking for approval to begin construction and receive a loan, we are additionally pledging our Fiesta money for the next five years, but still are about \$1.0 Million short of the needed amount. We are still hoping to begin this summer, as the longer we wait the more expensive the project becomes. We will be asking for approval from the Archdiocese to receive a loan for this balance and begin as soon as possible. I believe this is the wisest road forward, rather than waiting. We are reaching out to two foundations for additional support and are hopeful they can help. However, as we present this cause to possible funders, it is necessary that we convince them that we are doing the best we can. At present we have just over 40% of our church and school families participating in this campaign. While I am grateful for all who are donating, and encouraged by our progress so far, it would be a great boost to our cause if we had more participation. On top of the wall surrounding the new outdoor gathering area, we will place the names of all our donors who have pledged just slightly more than \$1 a day for the next five years. We are asking that if you have not yet contributed, would you? I would love to have that wall of names filled with every one of our parishioners, or the name of someone you wish to remember, so that for many years to come, as we gather before or after Masses to get to know each other better, we can all see the names and be reminded that we accomplished this together. In the back of the church you will see a picture of the donor wall. Those who pledge \$2,000 (\$1.10 a day for five years) will have a name in a standard listing. A pledge of \$5,000 will be remembered in a slightly larger listing with custom options, and a pledge of \$10,000 will be the largest located at the top of the wall. You can pledge online at [www.ourladyofguadalupechurch.org](http://www.ourladyofguadalupechurch.org), or using the envelopes in church (with the campaign prayer on the outside). I understand if you are not able to participate at these levels. I am grateful for whatever level you can help, even if it is just by your prayers. We will no longer be reciting the campaign prayer as part of our Sunday Mass intentions, but I would ask that you continue to pray it on your own, or in your own words. It is a prayer for the growth of our church, both the physical and the spiritual, and it describes what I believe God is calling us to do as together we write this next chapter in our history of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Thank you for your prayers and support. You are continually in my prayers.

### **Actualización de nuestra campaña de capital.**

Saludos y paz. Nuestra campaña "Construyendo nuestra fe" continúa como el diseño para agrandar nuestra iglesia y escuela; para agregar espacio a las oficinas y salas de conferencias en la escuela (lo que permite que las oficinas escolares actuales se conviertan en un espacio dedicado al uso de la pastoral o ministerios, un laboratorio de Ciencia, Ingeniería y Tecnología de la Ciencia (STEM), una sala de música y artes de uso general, y un espacio de reunión al aire libre adyacente a la entrada de la iglesia, todo esto espera los permisos finales de la ciudad de Hermosa. Esperamos que los documentos de construcción sean aprobados en cualquier momento. El siguiente paso en este proceso es reunirse con el Departamento de Servicios Financieros de la Arquidiócesis de Los Ángeles para recibir un préstamo que cubra el costo del proyecto que aún estamos recaudando. Hasta la fecha, hemos recaudado más de \$ 2.6 millones en efectivo y compromisos o promesas. Ahora que el diseño está completo, hemos podido obtener precios precisos. Hemos enviado los planos a tres contratistas para una oferta competitiva y hemos trabajado con los contratistas para reducir los costos lo más posible. El costo actual del proyecto es de \$ 3.8 millones. Esto es más alto que los \$ 3.0 millones que hemos estado usando como nuestra meta de recaudación de fondos. Las principales razones de este aumento son dos: los costos han aumentado desde la estimación hecha hace casi dos años, y el análisis de ingeniería de nuestro suelo después de la perforación ha determinado que se requiere un cimiento o base más grande de lo previsto. Para cubrir este costo mayor, cuando nos reunimos con la Arquidiócesis para solicitar la aprobación para comenzar la construcción y recibir un préstamo, estamos también comprometiendo el dinero de nuestra Fiesta de los próximos cinco años, pero aún nos faltan aproximadamente \$ 1.0 Millón de la cantidad necesaria. Todavía esperamos comenzar este verano, ya que cuanto más esperemos, más caro será el proyecto. Pediremos la aprobación de la Arquidiócesis para recibir un préstamo por este saldo y comenzar tan pronto como sea posible. Creo que este es el camino más sabio hacia adelante, en lugar de esperar. Estamos buscando el apoyo de dos fundaciones para obtener apoyo adicional y tenemos la esperanza de que nos puedan ayudar. Sin embargo, al presentar esta causa a posibles financiamientos es necesario que los convencamos de que estamos haciendo lo mejor que podemos. En la actualidad, tenemos más del 40% de las familias de nuestras iglesias y escuelas que participan en esta campaña. Si bien estoy agradecido por todos los que están donando, y alentado por nuestro progreso hasta ahora obtenido. Sería un gran impulso para nuestra causa si tuviéramos más participación. En la parte superior del muro que rodea la nueva área de reunión al aire libre, colocaremos los nombres de todos nuestros donantes que se han comprometido con un poco más de \$ 1 por día durante los próximos cinco años. Te preguntamos si aún no has contribuido, ¿lo harías? Me encantaría tener ese montón de nombres con cada uno de nuestros feligreses, o el nombre de alguien que deseamos recordar, de modo que durante los próximos años, al reunirnos antes o después de las Misas para conocernos más, todos podremos ver los nombres y recordar lo que se logró juntos. En la parte de atrás de la iglesia veras una imagen del muro de los donantes. Aquellos que se comprometen a dar \$ 2,000 (\$ 1.10 por día durante cinco años) tendrán un nombre en una lista estándar. Los que se comprometieron a dar \$ 5,000 los nombres serán ligeramente más grandes, y los que se comprometan con un monto de \$ 10,000 los nombres estarán más grandes ubicados en la parte superior del muro. 
