



October 15 is National Pregnancy and Infant Loss Remembrance Day

- One in four pregnancies ends in the loss of a baby
- The loss of a child is recognized as the most intense cause of grief
- Parents never “get over” the loss of a child – no matter the age
- Parents experiencing grief without supportive care can

have debilitating consequences such as PTSD, depression and anxiety that could further result in job loss, divorce, difficulties in daily living, or impediments with parenting of living children

The loss of a child stays with a family forever, but the emotional and physical impacts are often challenging to others to truly understand. Having support through grief is paramount to recovery. Raising awareness is the first step to accessing available help.

Next weekend, October 12 & 13th in addition to remembering all the angel babies we will also be remembering many of our friends and family members who have experienced pregnancy loss or lost a child. No person should ever have to go through such pain, but it does happen....and all we can do is be there for our friends & family and offer our prayers and support. Additionally, a lot of people suffer in silence in regards to miscarriage so let us remember and pray for them as well.

DIOS NUNCA NOS DEJARÁ

Estaba ardiendo una casa. Todos se habían salvado, excepto un niño, en el segundo piso. La escalera estaba llena de llamas y humo y no había salida sino por la ventana.--¡Papá, papá! ¿Cómo escaparé? --gritaba el niño.--Aquí estoy --gritaba el padre-- déjate caer, te recibiré en mis brazos; tírate. Luisito, yo te recibiré. Luis salió a gatas por la ventana, pero allí quedó agarrado, porque tenía miedo, sabiendo que era muy largo el trecho hasta la calle.--Suéltate, déjate caer --gritaba el padre.--No puedo verte, papá.--Pero yo si te veo: aquí estoy; ten confianza, suéltate, que yo te salvaré.-Tengo miedo de caer.--Suéltate, tírate --gritaban otras voces--, tu padre te recibirá con toda seguridad; no tengas miedo. Acordándose de la fuerza y del amor de su padre, el niño recobró la confianza y se dejó caer. A lo pocos instantes se halló salvo en los brazos de su padre. Entiendo perfectamente la frase de los apóstoles. "Auméntanos la fe" porque la fe a veces flojea y a veces desaparece sin saber cómo, quedando sólo la costumbre y la inercia surgida del grupo, de hacer las cosas como nuestro entorno. La fe --yo lo sé--es un don de Dios y sin esa gracia del Señor la fe no llega. Hay muchos ejemplos en la historia del cristianismo siendo los más relevantes por espectaculares los casos de San Pablo y San Agustín. Pero es verdad, por otro lado, que ya siendo personas de fe, se tiene la impresión, muchas veces, de que a veces la fe es la tenue chispa de una antigua llama que apenas podrá aguantar con un leve golpe de viento. Jesús los responde de una manera magistral: conoce la fe de sus discípulos y, prácticamente, les dice que su fe es casi inexistente y que si la fe, con toda la intensidad que Dios puede dar, estuviera en sus corazones harían verdaderas maravillas... casi, casi, podrían imitar el amor y el poder de Dios. Y a veces pedimos que aumente algo en nosotros, cuando, verdaderamente, no lo tenemos. O queremos decir que queremos mejorar, cuando, en realidad, ni siquiera nos hemos puesto en el camino del cambio y de la reforma de nuestras vidas. Una ventaja de no tener fe y luego tenerla es que se sabe de manera clara que ya se tiene fe en contraste y comparación de los momentos en que no se tenía. No. Esto no es un trabalenguas. Significa que aquel que ha vivido sin fe y Dios se la ha dado, sabe que la tiene por comparación con la época anterior. Y no es poco. No está mal, si a veces, reflexionamos en nuestra fe, en mi fe, en su fe, es muy conveniente. La rutina puede desdibujar nuestra fe y la conveniencia personal tiende a enfriarla. ¿Y cómo podríamos luchar contra todo estos efectos? Pues, creo que hay una pregunta muy sencilla y que está incluida en lo fundamental de nuestra fe: ¿amar a Dios sobre todas las cosas y al prójimo como a mí mismo? Y es que compartir a Dios con los ídolos materiales y situarnos nosotros mismos como figura predilecta --y casi única--de nuestros desvelos e intereses es una declaración clara de que ni tenemos fe, ni la deseamos. Y hay otra cuestión si creemos en un Dios lejano, poderoso, árbitro mudo de un universo imposible también esteremos con fe. El Dios que nos comunicó Cristo es el Dios del amor y si prescindimos del amor como combustible fundamental de nuestras vidas no podremos presumir de fe. De todas formas, tampoco es cuestión de angustiarse si nuestra alma está llena de dudas. Todo el mundo tiene dudas y estas van y vienen como las ráfagas de viento en un día tormentoso. Dios va a acompañarnos en nuestras dudas y si nuestro talante es humilde, lo más alejado que sea posible de la soberbia, vendrá en nuestra ayuda en cualquier momento. Lo que no podemos es intentar hacer un ejercicio de crecimiento de nuestra fe solo con nuestras fuerzas o por la influencia de un ambiente chato y repetitivo, que no ayuda y entenebrece las dudas. Ya vemos la historia de Luis , dudaba, pero decidió confiarle a las manos de su padre. La fe es la base de nuestra relación con Dios, no la perdamos, se hace con la oración y la vivencia de los sacramentos también. Bendiciones.



¿Que es Virtus?

VIRTUS es un programa creado por el Grupo Nacional Católico de Detección de Riesgos en los Estados Unidos con un componente de "Protección

a los hijos de Dios" que combate el abuso sexual de niños. Actualmente está en uso en más de 80 diócesis en los Estados Unidos. En VIRTUS se educa a las personas sobre cómo ocurre el abuso infantil, las señales que deben buscarse para ayudar a prevenirlo y qué hacer si se sospecha que alguien está siendo abusado o perjudicado. Todos los voluntarios y el personal que trabaja con niños deben recibir capacitación, y tomarse las huellas digitales, incluidos los padres que desean ayudar en el aula o en las excursiones. Did you Know?

Sometimes adults will exhibit behavior that, although not at the level of sexual abuse, is risky or inappropriate towards children in their care. In these cases, it's difficult, but important, to talk to the adult in question directly. Describe the behavior you witnessed, and why it made you feel uncomfortable. Be specific without generalizing or overdramatizing. Let the person know that you are concerned about how these actions could be seen by others, and what suspicions could arise. Stress the importance of role modeling for children in the person's care.

What is Virtus?

Virtus is a program created by the National Catholic Risk Retention Group in the United States with a "Protecting God's Children" component that combats sexual abuse of children. It is currently in use in over 80 dioceses in the United States. The Virtus educates people on how child abuse occurs, signs to look for to help prevent it, and what to do if you suspect someone is being abused or harmed. All volunteer and staff working with children must be trained and fingerprinted, including parents wanted to help out in the classroom or on field trips. Our next training will be held on 10/12/20 at 9-Noon or 1-4. To register please go to www.virtusonline.org/virtus/. Fingerprinting will also be available that day, by appointment only.
