

October 15 is National Pregnancy and Infant Loss Remembrance Day

- One in four pregnancies ends in the loss of a baby
- The loss of a child is recognized as the most intense cause of grief
- Parents never “get over” the loss of a child – no matter the age
- Parents experiencing grief without supportive care can have debilitating consequences such as PTSD, depression and anxiety that could further result in job loss, divorce, difficulties in daily living, or impediments with parenting of living children

The loss of a child stays with a family forever, but the emotional and physical impacts are often challenging to others to truly understand. Having support through grief is paramount to recovery. Raising awareness is the first step to accessing available help.

Today, in addition to remembering all the angel babies we will also be remembering many of our friends and family members who have experienced pregnancy loss or lost a child. No person should ever have to go through such pain, but it does happen...and all we can do is be there for our friends & family and offer our prayers and support. Additionally, a lot of people suffer in silence in regards to miscarriage so let us remember and pray for them as well.

Y... ¿QUÉ SE DICE?

Esta semana nuestra tarea estará enfocada en agradecer, en estar despiertos por las veces que no somos agradecidos y que debemos serlo. Vivimos en un mundo donde se pelea mucho por los derechos, pero no por los deberes que tenemos, y un deber que tenemos siempre es ser agradecidos. La gratitud es camino abierto a nuevas generosidades, a otros detalles o a que, aquel que salió a nuestro encuentro cuando le necesitábamos, vuelva a brindarse otra vez cuando haga falta. Muy al contrario, la ingratitud, es una actitud que nos cierra muchas ventanas. “Es la amnesia del corazón” (Gaspar Betancourt).

Es de agradecer que, personas que no tienen compromiso alguno con otras terceras, se detengan en su camino para socorrer. Algo así ocurrió en aquel encuentro de Jesús con los leprosos: se detuvo, miró su estado físico, espiritual y corporal... y los curó. Tan sólo uno de ellos tuvo la gentileza de, volviendo sobre sus pasos, darle las gracias por aquella curación.

Hemos avanzado mucho en la sociedad que nos toca vivir pero, también es verdad, que en algunos aspectos hemos ido dejando por el camino valores que –hasta hace cuatro días– formaban parte de la buena educación, de las mínimas normas de urbanidad o del respeto hacia los otros: el dar las gracias.

Nuestros padres o nuestros profesores, nuestros sacerdotes o los responsables de nuestra educación cuando éramos pequeños –al recibir un regalo– siempre nos solían enunciar: ¡qué se dice! Y, a continuación, conscientes de nuestro olvido respondíamos: ¡gracias!

También, respecto a Dios, somos tremendamente desagradecidos. Pensamos que los destinos del mundo, el día y la noche, el sol y la luna, la salud y el bienestar... depende exclusivamente del ser humano. ¿Por qué dar gracias? ¡Tengo derecho a la luz, a vivir, a ser feliz! Es un pensamiento habitual, incluso, en personas que nos decimos creyentes.

La eucaristía de cada domingo es un retroceder en nuestro caminar para dar gracias a Dios por los muchos beneficios que nos da; por la vida y por el trabajo, por los amigos y por la fe, por el presente y sobre todo por el futuro que junto a Él nos espera: el cielo.

El mes de octubre, además de ser un tiempo especialmente indicado para iniciar o recuperar el rezo del Santo Rosario, es un espacio reservado para dar gracias al Señor: los del campo por aquello que han recogido, los profesores por el curso recién iniciado, los padres por los hijos y por la familia, los sacerdotes porque –de nuevo– se nos envía a salir al encuentro de los que necesitan sanación o consuelo.

Pero, sobre todo, más allá del oportunismo, de lo que podemos considerar como imprescindible o válido para dar gracias a Dios que, hoy, no nos olvidemos de darle gracias por la fe. Una fe que nos hace confiar en Él, esperar en Él, apoyarnos en Él y curar nuestras dolencias en Él.

Hay mucho desagradecido suelto. Mucho hijo de Dios que, teniéndose como tal, olvida el rezar un padrenuestro antes de salir de casa o una jaculatoria mariana antes de acostarse. El mundo de las prisas, del individualismo y del egocentrismo hace que, también a nosotros, nos pase factura: pensamos que todo lo bueno viene de cualquier sitio... menos de Dios. Y, eso, no es así.

QUE NO ME OLVIDE, SEÑOR: Darte las gracias por lo mucho que me das y de esperar, cuando tardas en llegar Darte las gracias por los detalles insignificantes por los dones que, de tantas personas, recibo sin saberlo por las sonrisas que, por la calle, se me regalan por los rostros que no me son indiferentes.

Did you Know?

The Archdiocese of Los Angeles, along with five other dioceses in California, is participating in an independent program to offer persons who were victims of abuse as minors by diocesan priests, access to compensation as well as access to counseling services if they chose. Those harmed many years ago and barred from filing lawsuits because of civil statutes of limitations will be eligible to make claims under the Independent Compensation Program for Victim-Survivors of Sexual Abuse of Minors by Priests. The Archdiocese's participation in the program is part of a long-standing commitment to supporting and compensating victims of abuse, the protection of children and the vulnerable, and the prevention of abuse and misconduct in Catholic parishes, schools and ministries. Nationally recognized mediators and private compensation program administrators, Kenneth R. Feinberg and Camille S. Birros will administer the program. Funding for the program in our Archdiocese will come from self-insured reserves, monies set aside for this purpose. We pray that this new program might provide another avenue toward healing and hope.
