

I give thanks to God for you, and on behalf of Fr. Carlos, Fr. Peter, Fr. Joe, and Br. John wish you and your family a very Happy Thanksgiving. You are continually in our prayers. This Thanksgiving let us continue to give God thanks for all that is and that we are a part of. We especially thank God for the gift of our Salvation in Jesus Christ, which we celebrate every Eucharist (which means thanksgiving).

Advent begins on Sunday December 1st. Even though it is a busy time, I encourage all to find some extra time to prepare ourselves spiritually for the coming of Christ at Christmas. This year I have purchased two books to help us prepare. The first is the “Little Blue Book”, a series of short daily reflections for both the Advent and Christmas season by Bishop Kenneth Untener. (These books are available in both English and Spanish). Additionally, we have copies of a book from my favorite theologian; Brant Pitre, “Jesus and the Jewish Roots of Mary.” (In English only.) I would welcome everyone to take home a copy of these books for your own spiritual growth, or to give to another. I also would encourage you to get into small groups as a family or with friends to discuss the books. Here at the church, our Tuesday night faith share group will be discussing the book “Jesus and the Jewish Roots of Mary” on each Tuesday of Advent beginning on December 3rd. They meet from 7PM – 8:30PM in room 6.

The books are free, but a donation would be a blessing. In each book is an envelope you may use for this purpose. These donations will go towards the cost of these books, and the annual subscription for our parish to Formed.org. Are you currently signed up for Formed.org? It is free and gives you access to many movies, videos, audio books, and downloadable books about our Catholic Faith! Register through our parish website; ourladyofguadalupe.org.

Cristo es Rey del Universo, Demos Gracias a Dios.

En esta fiesta de Cristo Rey damos fin a este tiempo ordinario con el que nos hemos ido sumergiendo de lleno en la vida, muerte y resurrección de Jesús. ¿Lo hemos reconocido? ¿Hemos aceptado tantos dones de su gratuidad? ¿Hemos puesto nuestros corazones a su disposición?

Al igual que los soldados puede que, también nosotros, no entendamos el lenguaje que Jesús emplea desde la cruz. Por ello mismo, el Año de la Misericordia, ha tenido que contribuir a formarnos como católicos y como cristianos. Un cristiano sin formación queda a merced de las confusiones que otros presentan. El Señorío de Cristo lo contemplamos claramente en la Cruz, donde El da su vida por nuestra Salvación, démosle gracias.

Hoy es un buen momento para dar gracias a Dios pues estamos a las puertas de que miles de familias se reúnan para dar gracias a Dios, esta ocasión debe ser motivo de unión, agradecimiento, celebración de lo que tenemos y podemos tener. En fin este día nos dice que de muchas formas podemos ser agradecidos aun viviendo en situaciones de precariedad y dificultad.

La gratitud del hombre con corazón.

Hay una máxima que dice: «Es de bien nacidos el ser agradecidos». Pero no es sólo una muestra de cortesía, es, además, prueba de tener gran corazón y de humildad, y de tantas cosas más. Este agradecimiento ha de ser con todos, pero muy especialmente con Dios, de Quien proceden todos los bienes -«en verdad es justo y necesario (...) darte gracias siempre y en todo lugar...», decimos en el Prefacio de la Misa-; por eso don Josemaría solía rezar: «Gratias tibi, Deus, gratias tibi, pro universis beneficiis tuis etiam ignotis!» (te doy gracias, Señor, por todos tus dones, también por los beneficios que me concedes y que no conozco).

San Josemaría Escrivá era muy, pero que “muy” agradecido. Sin hacer alardes ni cosas raras, era habitual en él acompañar las frases más corrientes con un «gracias, hijo mío» (o, «hija mía»). Y, de verdad, se sentía totalmente agradecido por el más pequeño servicio recibido. Decía de modo gráfico que «si a Teresa de Jesús -según testimonio de ella misma- se la ganaban con una sardina, a mí me compran ¡con la raspa de una sardina!», o sea lo que queda en la lata.

Cuando falleció de repente su padre, San Josemaría aún no era sacerdote y estaba absolutamente sin medios económicos. Un sacerdote amigo le adelantó el dinero para sufragar los gastos del entierro. Le estuvo muy agradecido siempre y -aparte de que le devolvió el dinero en cuanto pudo- le encendió a diario en la Santa Misa, primero en el «memento» de vivos y, después de su muerte, en el «memento» de difuntos.

Nuestra Parroquia de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe siempre agradece y pide a Dios por sus feligreses y hoy queremos recordarles que están en nuestras oraciones siempre. Pero además queremos agradecerles todo lo que ustedes hacen unos por otros y por el servicio que prestan en las actividades que se ofrecen y en la liturgia especialmente. No es que tengo que hacer las cosas por la fuerza es que debemos tener un corazón agradecido reconociendo lo que a diario Dios nos da. La parte espiritual es lo que la parroquia puede brindar y ustedes son un apoyo en este aporte pues dan de su tiempo, de sus dones, de sus medios económicos, su vida, su amistad.

Que en este día y todos los días, sigan recibiendo las gracias que más necesitan en todo sentido, físico, material, espiritual, emocional. Oremos unos por otros y apoyemos la fe de todos, Dios nos quiere salvar a todos y este es nuestro espacio de apoyo, gracias de nuevo y bendiciones. Paz y Bien.

¿Sabías?

El desarrollar sus habilidades para escuchar activamente a los niños en su vida puede ayudarle a comunicarse con ellos con mayor efectividad, y además puede ayudarle a descubrir cualquier relación sospechosa o potencialmente dañina en sus vidas. El escuchar activamente le deja saber al orador que usted le ha escuchado, entendido y que usted valora lo que él o ella le ha dicho. Con frecuencia, los niños no se sienten escuchados, pero con unas pocas tácticas fáciles usted puede cambiar eso, construyendo relaciones de confianza y de respeto. Como un escuchador activo, asegúrese de ver al niño a los ojos mientras él o ella estén hablando. Haga preguntas de seguimiento y en ocasiones repita para asegurarse que ambos entienden lo que se ha dicho. Evite hacer preguntas cuyas respuestas solo sean “sí o no” y en su lugar haga preguntas de las que se puedan obtener respuestas amplias para que siga la conversación.

Christmas Food Drive



The Feast of Christ the King

Today is the Feast of Christ the King, the last Sunday of our Liturgical Year. We remember today that Christ is the Lord of life, the King of Salvation.

The King of Life

The liturgy for today's Feast of Christ the King tells us that this is "a kingdom of truth and life, a kingdom of holiness and grace, a kingdom of justice, love, and peace." Indeed, all these realities fit together perfectly. Truth and life go together, because when we know the truth about God's love and care for creation, we will respect all life. When we know the truth about ourselves, that we belong only to God, then we realize we cannot destroy any other person. A respect for life, personally as well as in our laws and policies as a nation, is the first requirement of justice and an absolute condition of peace. And the holier we are, the more we allow God's grace into our every thought and desire, the more we will adhere to truth, defend life, and promote justice and peace.
