Latest update on Liturgical restrictions



The dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass is being continued indefinitely, and for now we continue to operate as we have been. We do hope to move towards reopening as soon as possible, and it would most likely be in stages, and continuing to work in coordination with government and health guidelines out of concern for the safety of all. I know that the current situation is very difficult to not receive the Eucharist, and worship together, but let us continue to persevere during these times, in today's Gospel Jesus does say "***I will never leave you...***"

Nos ha permitido esta crisis entrar a nuestra casa, no solo material sino personal , humana. Seguramente nos hemos encontrado con sorpresas , al igual que los discípulos encontraron sorpresas y dificultades.


