### Update on the Capital Campaign by Fr. Paul

A few weeks back I announced at a Mass that due to the pandemic, our building project to add on to the school and church, had "slowed down." As you may recall, we were planning to begin construction in May or June. The project was to take about 10 months. Just under two weeks ago, we learned that the reason behind the slow down, was that the Archdiocese was re-evaluating their financial responsibilities during this economic downturn, and assessing how much difficulty parishes and schools across the archdiocese were having with loss of income from the cancellation of public Masses, and the other effects of the pandemic on the economy. The Archdiocese has recently decided that they cannot afford to lend money for any new building projects at this time. Although I am disappointed for the effect of that decision to our hope of beginning the project now, the decision makes sense to me. The Archdiocese is choosing to use all their assets to commit to supporting parishes and schools who may be struggling during these difficult economic times.

Where does this leave our Building Project? The Archdiocese had estimated that we would need a line of credit up to \$758,000 to get us entirely through the 10-month construction period. Whatever amount we did use, was to be paid back over a 7 years period at 3% interest. Since the Archdiocese cannot give us a loan at this time, we are seeking a similar loan from other sources. If we are to begin construction yet this summer, we would need to have \$758,000 more money in cash as either a donation or loan. I along with Mrs. Beuder the school principal, in consultation with the finance council, are still praying, hoping, and looking for a way to go forward. If you have any ideas, of how we may raise this amount as either a donation or a loan, please I would love to hear!

I hope that I can still count on your support during this delay. **We are so close.** We have raised over \$3.15 Million, due to the generosity and trust of so many. I ask that you continue making your pledge payments if your financial situation allows. If you have not yet pledged, or can increase your pledge, I ask that you consider that. I thank so many who have generously donated so far. I still believe that together we will accomplish this much needed project for our Parish so that we may continue to offer the best possible education and faith development for our families now and for many years to come.

### *Actualización sobre la Campaña Capital por el p. Pablo*

Hace unas semanas anuncié en una misa que, debido a la pandemia, nuestro proyecto de construcción para agrandar la escuela y la iglesia, se había "demorado". Como recordarán, estábamos planeando comenzar la construcción en mayo o junio. El proyecto demoraría unos 10 meses. Hace poco menos de dos semanas, supimos que la razón detrás de la demora o el atraso, era que la Arquidiócesis estaba reevaluando sus responsabilidades financieras durante esta recesión económica y accediendo a la dificultad que tenían las parroquias y las escuelas de toda la arquidiócesis con la pérdida de ingresos de la cancelación de misas públicas y los otros efectos de la pandemia en la economía. La Arquidiócesis ha decidido recientemente que no pueden permitirse financiar ningún proyecto para nueva construcción en este momento. Aunque estoy decepcionado por el efecto de esa decisión es nuestra esperanza de comenzar el proyecto ahora, la decisión tiene sentido para mí. La Arquidiócesis está eligiendo usar todos sus activos para comprometerse a apoyar a las parroquias y escuelas que pueden estar luchando durante estos tiempos económicos difíciles.

¿Dónde queda ahora nuestro proyecto de construcción? La Arquidiócesis había estimado que necesitaríamos una línea de crédito de hasta \$ 758,000 para ayudarnos a completar el período de construcción de 10 meses. Cualquier cantidad que usáramos, debía devolverse durante un período de 7 años con un interés del 3%. Como la Arquidiócesis no puede otorgarnos un préstamo en este momento, estamos buscando un préstamo similar por otras fuentes. Si vamos a comenzar la construcción aún este verano, necesitaríamos tener \$ 758,000 más en efectivo como donación o préstamo. Yo, junto con la Sra. Beuder, directora de la escuela, en consulta con el consejo de finanzas, todavía rezo, espero y busco una manera de seguir adelante. Si tienen alguna idea de cómo podemos recaudar esta cantidad como donación o préstamo, ¡me encantaría saberlo!

Espero poder contar con su apoyo durante este retraso. Estamos tan cerca. Hemos recaudado más de \$ 3.15 millones, debido a la generosidad y la confianza de muchos. Les pido que continúen haciendo sus pagos de compromiso si su situación financiera lo permite. Si aún no se ha comprometido, o puede aumentar su compromiso, le pido que lo considere. Agradezco a tantos que generosamente han donado hasta ahora. Todavía creo que juntos lograremos este proyecto tan necesario para nuestra parroquia para que podamos continuar ofreciendo la mejor educación y desarrollo de fe posible para nuestras familias ahora y durante muchos años por venir.

Pedimos tu ayuda al recurrir a tu Hijo, buscando el perdón por las veces en que hemos fallado en amarnos y respetarnos.

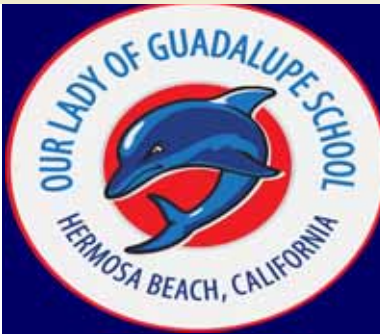

## *Reflexión dominical del p. Carlos*

### **Cáliz y el Pan de Vida**

La fiesta del «Corpus Domini» asume un significado del todo especial cada vez que celebramos la eucaristía. Uno de los frutos que el Papa Juan Pablo II fue animar y celebrar la eucaristía en tantas visitas que hizo a diferentes continentes y lo mismo el Papa Francisco lo vemos como ha celebrado o ha llevado la eucaristía a ambientes que no pensábamos, y eso porque? pues precisamente porque la eucaristía no tiene fronteras es el alimento de salvación, sanación, amor, perdón, compasión, es Cristo que viene a dársenos como alimento espiritual.

En la segunda lectura de la fiesta del día, San Pablo escribe: «La copa de bendición que bendecimos ¿no es acaso comunión con la sangre de Cristo? Y el pan que partimos ¿no es comunión con el cuerpo de Cristo?». La Eucaristía es por lo tanto fundamentalmente un misterio de comunión. Conocemos distintos tipos de comunión. Una, muy íntima, es aquella entre nosotros y el alimento que comemos, porque éste se convierte en carne de nuestra carne y sangre de nuestra sangre. He oído a las madres decir a sus niños, mientras las estrechan contra su pecho y las besan: «¡Te quiero tanto que te comería!». Es verdad que el alimento no es una persona viva e inteligente con la que podamos intercambiar pensamientos y afectos, pero supongamos por un momento que el alimento fuera él mismo vivo e inteligente, ¿no parece que entonces se tendría finalmente la perfecta comunión? Esto es precisamente lo que ocurre en la comunión eucarística. Jesús, en el pasaje evangélico, dice: «Yo soy el pan vivo, bajado del cielo... Mi carne es verdadera comida... Quien come mi carne tiene vida eterna». Aquí el alimento no es una cosa, sino que es una persona viva. Se tiene la más íntima, si bien también la más misteriosa, de las comuniones.

Por eso debemos ser muy cuidadosos cuando la recibimos, es un compromiso de amor que debe ser llevado a los demás a través de nuestras acciones, practicando la justicia, ayudando al necesitado, perdonando al que ofendió o recibiendo el perdón del que me lo ofrece. Esta es la forma como nos alimenta, nos debe hacer cambiar de actitud, no podemos seguir siendo los mismos egoístas, indiferentes, injustos con los demás, especialmente a aquellos que nos quieren más.

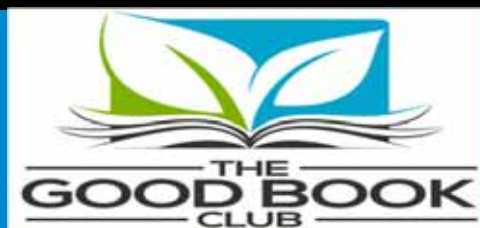
Un famoso materialista ateo dijo: «El hombre es lo que come». Sin saberlo dio una definición óptima de la Eucaristía. Gracias a ésta, el hombre se convierte verdaderamente en lo que come, ¡o sea, cuerpo de Cristo! Leemos a continuación del texto inicial de San Pablo: «Porque aun siendo muchos, un sólo pan y un solo cuerpo somos, pues todos participamos de un solo pan». Está claro que en este segundo caso la palabra «cuerpo» ya no indica el cuerpo de Cristo nacido de María, sino que indica «todos nosotros», indica ese cuerpo de Cristo mayor que es la Iglesia. Esto quiere decir que la comunión eucarística es siempre también comunión entre nosotros. Comiendo todos del único alimento, formamos un solo cuerpo. ¿Cuál es la consecuencia? Que no podemos hacer verdadera comunión con Cristo si estamos divididos entre nosotros, nos odiamos, no estamos dispuestos a reconciliarnos. Al darnos la hostia, el sacerdote dice: «El cuerpo de Cristo», y nosotros respondemos: «¡Amén!». Ahora sabemos a quién decimos «Amén», esto es: «Sí, te acojo»: no sólo a Jesús, el Hijo de Dios, sino también a quien tenemos al lado. Vivamos la Eucaristía con la misma intensidad siempre, Él está ahí, no importa nuestra situación, Él está Ahí, para todos. Amen.

## *Protegiendo a los hijos de Dios*



### **Enseñe a sus hijos actividades diarias para reducir la propagación de los gérmenes**

Siempre es apropiado recordarles a sus hijos con frecuencia las formas de evitar o reducir la propagación de los gérmenes para que los empiecen a practicar en el hogar. Entre los consejos están: Alejarse de las personas que estén tosiendo, estornudando o enfermas. Recuérdeles que ellos mismos deben toser o estornudar siempre tapándose la boca con un pañuelo de papel o colocando su boca sobre su codo, y que luego deben tirar el pañuelo de papel a la basura. Enseñe a sus hijos a desarrollar el hábito de lavarse las manos con frecuencia. Enséñeles a lavarse las manos con agua y jabón durante por lo menos 20 segundos, especialmente después de que se suenen la nariz, después de toser o de estornudar; de ir al baño; y antes de comer o de preparar la comida. Si no hay agua y jabón disponible, enséñeles cómo usar los desinfectantes de manos. Estos desinfectantes deben contener al menos 60 por ciento de alcohol. Supervise a los niños pequeños cuando usen el desinfectante de manos para prevenir que traguen alcohol. ### DID YOU KNOW?

**Teach children everyday actions to reduce the spread of germs**

It is appropriate to frequently remind your children about ways to avoid or reduce the spread of germs and to start practicing at home. Among the tips are: Stay away from people who are coughing, sneezing or sick. Remind them to cough or sneeze into a tissue or their elbow, then throw the tissue into the trash. Get the children into a handwashing habit. Teach them to wash their hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after blowing their nose, coughing, or sneezing; going to the bathroom; and before eating or preparing food. If soap and water are not available, teach them to use hand sanitizer. Hand sanitizer should contain at least 60% alcohol. Supervise young children when they use hand sanitizer to prevent swallowing alcohol.
