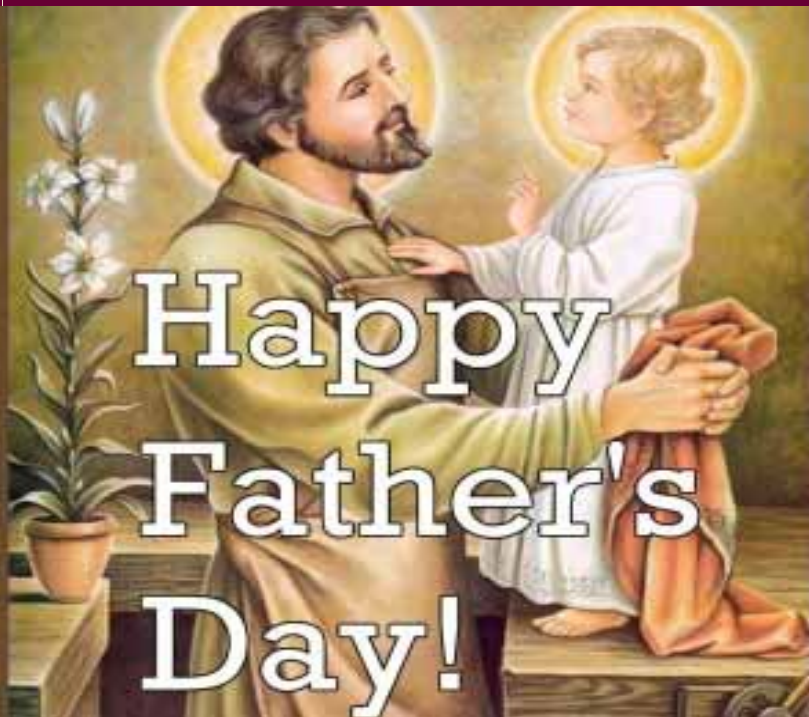

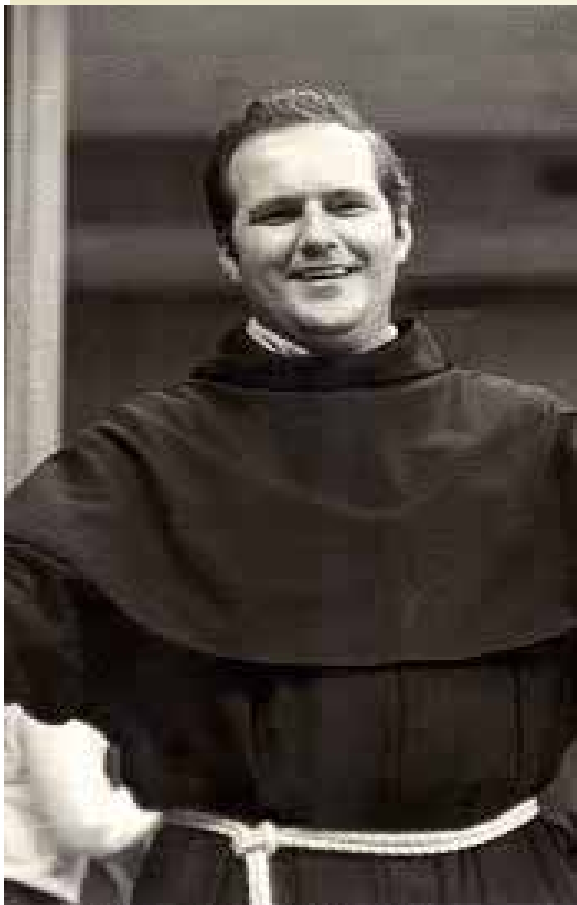

Remembering Fr. Casimir Cypher, OFM Conv. (1941-1975)

June 25th is the 45th anniversary of the death of Fr. Casimir Cypher OFM Conv. Who was martyred in Honduras on 1975

Today (June 25th) marks the 45th anniversary of the death of one of our friars, Fr. Casimir Cypher, OFM Conv. Fr. Casimir was born in Medford, WI in 1941. He entered the Conventual Franciscan Friars' Minor Seminary in Crystal Lake, IL, eventually being ordained a priest in 1968. After serving as a parish priest in Rockford, IL and at Our Lady of Guadalupe here in Hermosa Beach, CA, Fr. Casimir received permission to fulfill his long-time dream of serving as a missionary.

Fr. Casimir arrived in Honduras in 1973, living and ministering in the remote and rugged state of Olancho - the "Wild West" of Honduras. It was only a little more than a year after being missioned to Honduras that Fr. Casimir (or "Padre Casimiro" as the local villagers called him) was caught up in a violent storm of unrest. For some time, the oppressed peasant farmers (or "campesinos") had been organizing for land reform, much to the anger of the military dictatorship then ruling

Honduras and their wealthy, land-owning supporters. The Catholic Church supported the campesinos in their struggle for justice, leading to a nation-wide persecution of the Church. The military searched retreat and catechetical centers throughout the country, seized radios, and arrested priests, religious and laypeople working with the Church.

On June 25, 1975, Fr. Casimir drove his borrowed pickup into the city of Juticalpa for repairs. He was unaware that the National Union of Campesinos had organized a demonstration that day for better implementation of land reform legislation. Hearing gunshots, Fr. Casimir ran toward the commotion. Knowing that he was a priest, soldiers arrested him. He was stripped in the town square, ridiculed, and beaten. Along with another priest, Fr. Ivan Betancort, two of Fr. Ivan's companions, and ten campesino leaders, Fr. Casimir was brutally tortured and executed. His body and those of the others killed with him were then thrown into a deep well and dynamited in an attempt to cover up the massacre. Fr. Casimir was only 34 years old. This night of diabolical violence is known in Honduras as the "Los Horcones" (or "Pitchforks," after the name of the ranch on which the killings took place) Massacre. Fr. Casimir's remains were recovered shortly after and eventually buried in the church of St. Jerome in Gualaco, Honduras.

Fr. Casimir was a true son of St. Francis. His life was characterized by simplicity, personal poverty, and a good sense of humor. He painted, wrote poetry, and loved serving the poor and disadvantaged. May his example inspire us to love and serve Christ in the poor and marginalized!

She has served the parish LOVINGLY, and with Joy and Cheerfulness, for more than 30 years!

I wish to publicly thank her, and share my belief that God will reward her tremendously for all she has given to God in service.

Regretfully due to current restrictions of the pandemic we can only have a humble celebration. We will have a Mass of Thanksgiving on Friday July 10 at 5PM. The event will be livestreamed for all the parish to watch, and **I am asking each of you to submit a short video or picture to express your feelings and gratitude to Jodi.** We will show some of these videos during the Mass, and make a full length feature film, a blockbuster hit I'm sure, movie to give to Jodi as a retirement gift. Regretfully, since the number who can attend the Mass will be limited because of our current restrictions, attendance at the Mass in person will be by invitation only, and will consist mostly of Jodi's family, the Friars, and a few parishioners.

I am hoping all will understand this restriction, and make up for it by an overwhelming number who contribute to the video of gratitude we are making by following the instructions below from Jan Vega from our Parish Council who has volunteered to oversee the making of the video.

Profetas y llamado-misión.

Feliz día a todos los padres de familia, los que valientemente hacen presente a Dios en sus hogares y lo colocan al centro de su familia. Bendiciones a todos y que Dios los fortalezca siempre.

Estamos en la semana XII del tiempo ordinario y hoy las lecturas nos van a hacer pensar en la misión del profeta, del misionero, catequista, o todo aquel que tiene un ministerio o servicio en la Iglesia en medios diferentes pero que lo hace desde su ser como cristiano, como bautizado y lo toma como el llamado que Dios le hace a extender su Reino de Justicia y de paz en la tierra.

Jesús, ante los momentos de persecución a los que se van a enfrentar los discípulos, les transmite confianza y valor en la persecución y les exhorta a "no tener miedo". Para que los discípulos superen esos miedos y la angustia que les supone la persecución les trasladará fuerza a través de tres motivaciones:

1.- No hay nada encubierto que no llegue a saberse. 2.- No teman a los que pueden matar el cuerpo pero no pueden matar el alma. Y la tercera ustedes valen mucho más que muchos pajaritos.

Los cristianos deberíamos hacernos eco continuamente de estas palabras de Jesús que nos invitan a superar nuestros miedos ante los nuevos retos que la sociedad nos va planteando. A veces a los bautizados les da pena servir o mostrarse como cristiano comprometido, miedo, inseguridad, temor, y lo que más nos ataja a veces es la propia familia con sus comentarios no tan positivos, pero ahí está lo que dijo Jesús 'teman a quien puede matar el cuerpo pero no el alma. "Dejemos esos prejuicios o miedos y comencemos a servir.

Jeremías nos muestra su lucha interna como hombre de Dios, se reconoce llamado y seducido por Dios y le da miedo ya que tiene que predicar lo que a la gente no le gustara escuchar.. El profeta siente que los que no están con él le acechan y están siempre seguros de que caerá; que los sencillos que le siguen se darán cuenta de que el profeta les engaña. Este es el "sino" del verdadero profeta: nunca le concederán la razón. Es verdad que el profeta ha sido fuerte, incluso ha hablado contra el templo (7,1-15) en un discurso que es una prefiguración de lo que diría también Jesús.

La verdad del llamado de Jesús a los apóstoles y a los profetas y hoy a nosotros no será fácil pero cuando la entiendes y la abrazas puedes hacer lo que dice, prediquen sin miedo, y lo que les digo al oído pregónenlo sin temor alguno. Y si posiblemente algunos tienen consecuencias feas al recibir y defender este llamado, pero no están liquidándole el alma. Es solo la posibilidad de hacerse sabio y fuerte en medio de la adversidad.

Tampoco está todo en hacer una lectura de la verdad del evangelio con carácter "expansivo", sino transformador. De esa manera cobran sentido las palabras sobre los mensajeros, las dificultades de ser rechazados y la exhortación a una "autoestima" cuando se lleva en el alma y en el corazón la fuerza de la verdad que ha de transformar el mundo y la historia. Jesús pronunció estas palabras recogidas por Mateo, en el discurso de misión, sabiendo que el rechazo de los mensajeros estaba asegurado. Paz y Bien.
