***Who Do you Love?***

Jesus asks his disciples to have total dedication to following him. As an example, he tells us that to be worthy we must love him more than we love our parents or children. If we see someone in our family stray from the faith, we try to bring them back by our prayers, example, and encouragement.

Jesus then gives examples of three kinds of disciples. First are the prophets. These are people who have lived the faith and are able to teach others the wisdom they have learned. Second are the righteous, those whose quiet lives teach by example. Many good parents practice this type of discipleship. Children may not listen to their parents' advice, but still grow up with memories of how they lived. Finally, there are the "little ones." These, like children, follow Jesus with great joy and love. They may be elderly, or disabled. When we respect and cherish them, we are able to see Jesus in them. And anytime we can experience Jesus through another person is a wonderful reward for a disciple

***CHRISTIAN HOSPITALITY***

Day in and day out, we are required to make judgment calls informed by tough, durable, serviceable Christian love. We do what we can do, and God takes notice. God is in charge of rewards, and a glass of water will do when that is what we have to offer with a glad and open heart.

Paul gives us a clear theology for the missionary work we do whenever anybody is close at hand. He reminds us that our work, our ministry, is carried on in concert with Christ. We have been baptized into his death and life. In any given moment both life and death are there, a kind of play of shadow and light. Sometimes it's difficult to tell where shadow leaves off and light begins. God will take care of that, too.

The National Institute on Alcohol Abuse and Alcoholism reports that nearly 5,000 children under the age of 21 die from alcohol-related incidents every year. Studies show that children as young as 12 may be exposed to alcohol and drugs, and nearly

### *Acoger al hermano es acoger a Jesús*

En el domingo XIII del Tiempo Ordinario, recordamos que Dios siempre nos está hablando de muchas formas, que no es fácil discernir su voz y su presencia, no porque él sea difícil, sino porque nuestro mundo está muy lleno de cuestiones sociales que nos confunden, nos apartamos comprometen, lo importante sería discernir, como Dios me está llamando a servir, a comprometerme en situaciones que a veces ni pienso que vienen de Él.

La mujer de Sunem era evidentemente una mujer con influencia, aun en su propio matrimonio. El autor dice claramente que es ella, y no su esposo, quien invita al profeta a comer en el hogar de ellos. Además no le pregunta, sino le sugiere a su esposo construir una habitación para Eliseo. Ella está resuelta a ofrecerle una hospitalidad más allá de lo esperado por su propio esposo y por el mismo Eliseo. Dios recompensa su generosidad con un hijo. Pero ella no hizo las cosas sabiendo esto. Le había preparado una habitación al profeta de Dios. Eliseo le promete que Dios preparara el seno de ella para recibir una vida nueva. La ley de la hospitalidad es una antigua ley en muchas culturas y también en nuestra cultura. Es un valor que no hay que perder sino cultivar y reforzar.

Cuando nosotros fuimos bautizados nos echaron un poco de agua en la cabeza, pero para apreciar de veras la primera frase de la segunda lectura debemos imaginarnos el bautismo por inmersión. Eso era lo corriente en tiempo de San Pablo, se consumía a la persona en el agua, como si fuera una piscina o sea, que cuando era sumergido, el que se bautizaba no podía respirar por unos segundos. Estaba muriendo con Cristo. Cuando lo alzan a la superficie recibe una vida nueva y transformada. Nosotros los cristianos estamos llamados a sepultar nuestra vida de pecado y vivir una vida nueva de santidad.

Las palabras de Jesús en el Evangelio nos dan la razón profunda por la que la hospitalidad se convierte para el cristiano en algo más que una norma o una tradición. Jesús nos dice que recibir al que se acerca a nosotros, abrirle nuestra casa y nuestra amistad es como recibirle a él. Esa es la clave. Jesús mismo es el que pasa por delante de nuestra puerta y de nuestra vida. Jesús es el que nos llama y nos pide albergue.

En nuestro mundo, sin embargo, la hospitalidad se va perdiendo. A los otros, a los desconocidos, que son la inmensa mayoría, los vemos, casi por principio, como una amenaza para nuestra tranquilidad, para nuestra paz. Jesús nos invita a no vivir tan centrados en nosotros mismos. Eso es lo que quiere decir cuando habla de que debemos "perder nuestra vida".

Jesús nos pide que dejemos de mirarnos a la punta de nuestra nariz, a nuestros problemas y abramos la mano al vecino, aunque piense diferente, sea de otra raza, lengua o religión. Nos encontraremos con una persona, con parecidos problemas a los nuestros, y descubriremos que juntos podemos ser más felices que separados por barreras y armas. Pero hay algo más. Desde nuestra fe, sabemos que ése que tenemos enfrente, por amenazador que parezca, es nuestro hermano. Es Cristo mismo.

Debemos permitirnos ver el mundo desde la perspectiva de Dios. Lo hago? No es fácil pero debemos intentarlo día a día. Bendiciones. Paz y Bien.


