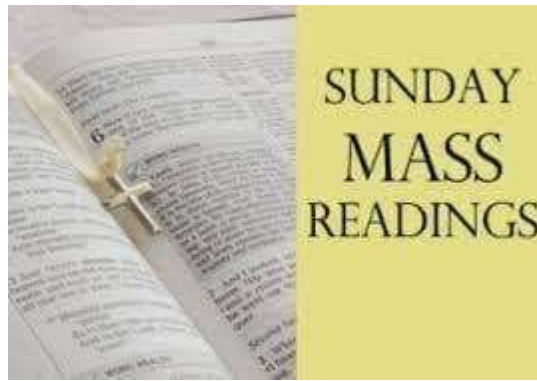

- Overseeing accounting, budget, record keeping, employee files, and sacramental records,
- Recruiting and managing office some office staff – especially receptionists,
- Overseeing facilities maintenance,
- General communications to church members including phone, mail, and email,
- Processing incoming mail and emails,
- Maintaining parishioner database,
- Doing and overseeing clerical functions, including copying, answering the door,

phone, and scheduling Mass intentions,

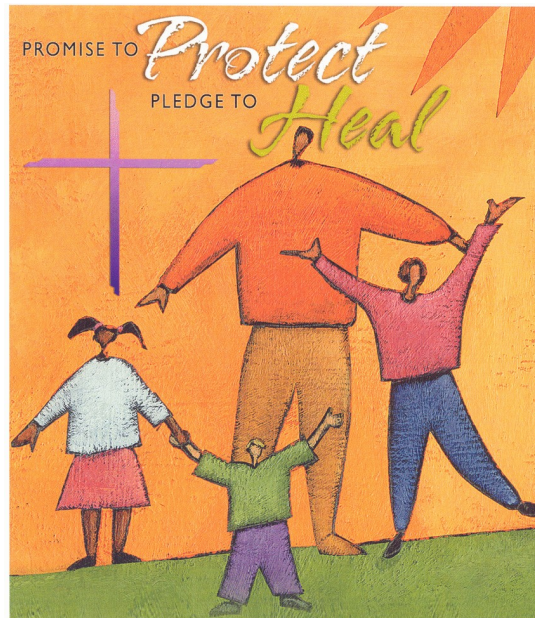
- Scheduling rooms for ministry (primarily through electronic calendars and email) and ensuring proper cleaning of them,
- Assisting in administrative aspects of evangelization events,
- Promotion of Gospel through social media and website, and
- Work in coordination with the priests with families to arrange for funerals, baptisms, weddings, quinceñeras.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

Because all Archdiocesan employees represent the Roman Catholic Church, they are expected to conduct themselves according to the goals and mission of the Church in performing their work. More specifically, the following characteristics are required:

- Positive and joyful collaborative member of a team and an excellent communicator.
- Person of faith and prayer, who knows the faith, can discourse about faith and pastorally support others in the living of their faith.
- Open to taking direction, an active listener, but also a self-starter and willing to take responsibility and for doing whatever is necessary, in close coordination with the pastor, to see the parish thrive and be the best it can be.

Did You Know?

Understanding relational bullying

Relational bullying is unwarranted, persistent, unwelcome behavior in the form of criticism, isolation, or false allegations and rumors that damage the targeted

person's relationships. Relational bullying includes social exclusion, gossip, and withholding friendship, and it can be devastating for children and teens. These behaviors are more subtle than traditional bullying, often happening out of sight or earshot of adults. But this bullying requires intervention and action. Talk to your children about these behaviors, especially if you notice them being left out of social activities and friendships. Un mensaje del p. Carlos

COMIDA Y EUCARISTÍA

Estamos en el domingo XVIII del tiempo ordinario y las lecturas nos llevan a una meditación muy importante este día, tiene que ver con el alimento, la comida, la vida. Para todos es familiar que la comida es algo decimos sagrado, es fundamental en todas las culturas, razas, idiomas. Alrededor de una mesa, una comida, se celebra, se anuncia, se solidariza, se ora, canta, medita y se celebran los rituales oficiales de la Iglesia, la liturgia.

El profeta (primera lectura) subraya insistentemente la gratuidad de la comida y de la bebida: “Oigan sedientos todos; acudan por agua también los que no tienen dinero; vengan, compren trigo; coman sin pagar, vino y leche de balde. ¿Por qué gastan dinero en lo que no alimenta?”. El agua hace referencia a la vida, a la libertad, al Espíritu, al templo de Jerusalén, fuente de agua viva. El vino y la leche son dos signos de la fertilidad de la tierra de la promesa y de la bendición del Señor. El trigo y el pan es el sustento básico e indispensable para poder subsistir, mientras que los manjares suculentos evocan el banquete mesiánico. El simbolismo de la comida alcanza la plenitud de su expresividad en la narración de la multiplicación de

los panes. En el transcurso teológico de este acontecimiento está el maná del Éxodo y los panes de Eliseo, pero sobre todo la institución de la Eucaristía.

De muchas y variadas formas Jesús nos enseña a valorar lo que nosotros ahora llamamos la cena pascual o la eucaristía. Hay un mensaje en sus milagros, en su actuación con los demás, Jesús no deja con hambre a nadie, con hambre de ningún tipo, El ayuda, consuela, perdona, acompaña, libera, corrige con amor y perdón, estas son formas de como Jesús alimenta a los demás, a los que andan cansados por la angustia, la crisis, la duda, los problemas etc. “levantar los ojos al cielo, pronunciar la bendición, partir y repartir el pan”.

Tenemos que relacionar este domingo de celebración de la fe centrado en dos alimentos, la palabra de Dios y la presencia real de Jesús en la Eucaristía, alimento para la salvación y para el alma. Pero de ahí tiene que ir un poco más allá, fuera de las cuatro paredes del templo, o de mi casa. Tiene que ir a aquellos necesitados, hambrientos, desesperados, confundidos, los desfavorecidos de nuestro tiempo. Siempre habrá alguien, una familia que necesitara nuestra solidaridad, es ahí donde debemos poner en práctica lo que celebramos en la comunidad de fe, es ahí donde Cristo pasa necesidad y sufre. ¿Estamos ayudando? / ¿Auxiliamos con lo que podemos a aquellos que están hambrientos de cualquier forma?

Es incompleto el servicio sacramental de la Iglesia si no va acompañado del servicio de la caridad. No podemos partir el pan en la Eucaristía si no nos comprometemos a repartirlo fuera de ella y no nos podemos quedar en repartir el pan para el cuerpo, si no cultivamos y anunciamos también el deseo del pan del espíritu, la Palabra de Dios.

Centremos nuestras vidas, nuestras familias en el alimento que no acaba, pero también en alimentar al que está a nuestro lado, espiritual o materialmente. Que esta palabra nos inunde de solidaridad, de amor por los que sin pedir nada nos necesitan. Paz y Bien.

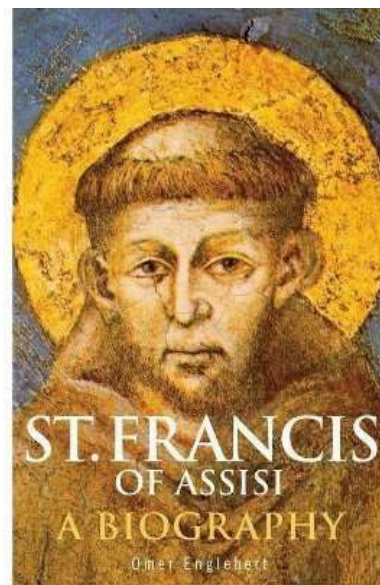

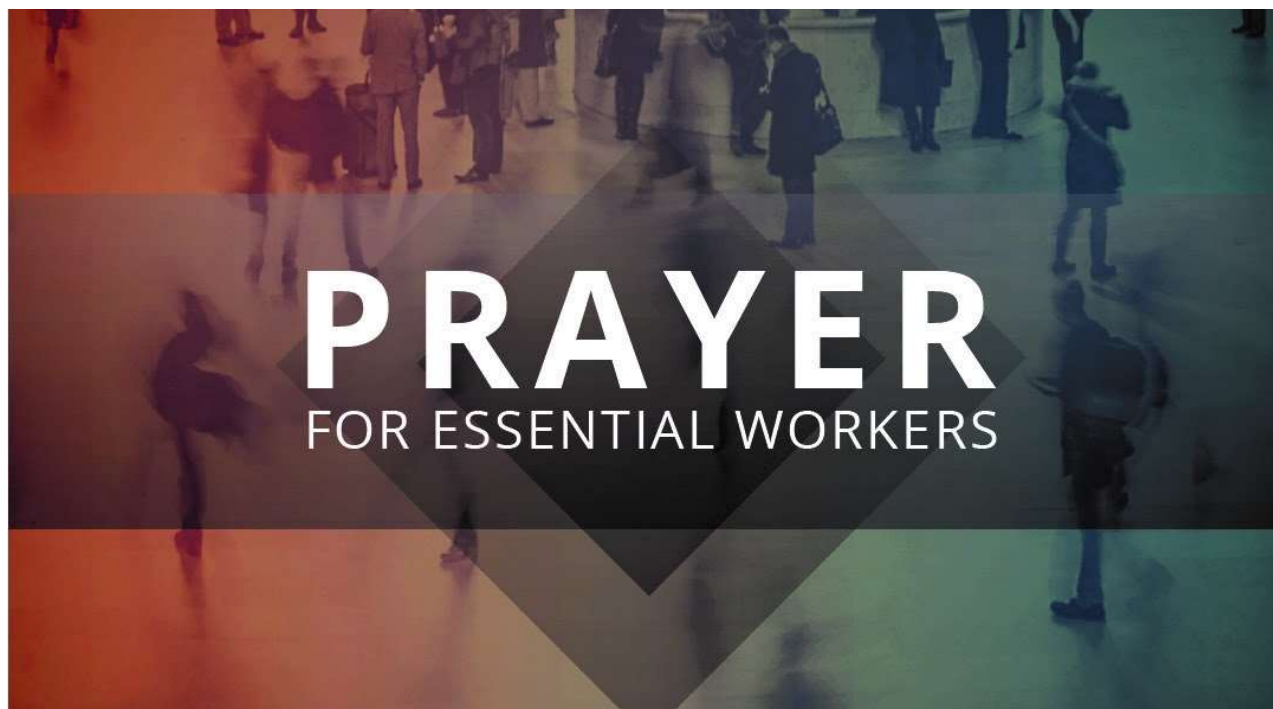
