

## Mass Indoors or Outdoors?

As you may have already read, because of Supreme Court rulings in similar cases, LA county will no longer attempt to prevent Religious Services from being indoors; however, it is highly recommended that Churches continue to worship outdoors. Additionally, our Archbishop has given the same directive, namely that it is best if we continue outdoors for now. Currently, we have moved the 8 AM Daily Mass and 7 AM Sunday Mass indoors to the church as the number of persons attending these Masses are small. For now, we will continue all other Masses outside in the church parking lot. # Un mensaje del p. Carlos

## **TAMBIEN NOSOTROS ABRAMOS NUESTRA BIBLIA.**

Hoy es un día de mucha fuerza en el desarrollo de la evangelización o sea Jesús no se detiene, no tiene miedo, habla donde debe hablar y en este caso, ha estado o entrado a la Sinagoga y para haber hecho esto, su preparación tenía que estar lista para afrontar las situaciones que vendrían.

Lo que resuena hoy es , quien es este? Habla como quien tiene autoridad, o sea podían distinguir entre Jesús y los anteriores Mesías, y dicen hasta los demonios le obedecen. Aún no saben quién es, no asocian su presencia con la promesa del Antiguo Testamento. Pero ahí empieza, la curiosidad y admiración y hasta el enojo con El hacen que muchos lo sigan, lo conozcan, quieran pedirle su intervención.

El Señor Jesús no es un gran maestro o un gurú más entre varios .Quien así piensa no ha comprendido o aceptado que Él es el Hijo mismo de Dios, Dios de Dios y Luz de Luz. En cuanto tal, Él está muy por encima de cualquier maestro, sabio o iluminado que hayan pisado nuestro suelo. Nosotros afirmamos y creemos firmemente lo que la Iglesia ha recibido de los apóstoles y nos ha transmitido a cada uno de nosotros: que Cristo el Señor es la Palabra eterna que desde siempre ha estado con Dios, la Palabra creadora por la que todo lo visible e invisible ha pasado de la nada a la existencia. Él mismo es la Palabra divina que se hizo hombre para hablarnos en lenguaje humano del misterio de Dios y del misterio del ser humano. Él es la Palabra Viva que es la Vida y la Verdad que ilumina a todo hombre que viene a este mundo (ver Jn 1,9).

Mas aunque el Señor Jesús por su condición divina tenga plena autoridad y poder sobre todo lo creado, sobre el mal y la muerte, su poder se detiene, o habría que decir mejor que se estrella ante la libertad del ser humano: su Palabra se torna ineficaz ante un corazón que se cierra y se endurece, que consciente o inconscientemente desoye a Dios. Y es que Dios que nos ha creado libres — porque nos ha creado para participar de su mismo amor y porque el amor no se impone— respeta a todo aquel que le dice: “no quiero que Tú entres en mi vida y me digas lo que tengo que hacer o no hacer para ser feliz. Yo quiero definir por mí mismo qué es lo bueno y qué es lo malo para mí. Yo quiero ser mi propio dios, dueño de mi propia vida y constructor de mi propio destino, no quiero que Tú te entrometas, no quiero que Tú me limites”. ¡Cuántas veces le decimos “no” a Dios porque lo vemos como un enemigo de nuestra felicidad, porque “no me deja hacer lo que más me place, lo que a mí me gusta, lo que me deleita o me produce algún éxtasis intenso, lo que según mi criterio me hace feliz”!

No dejemos que el la fascinación del mundo nos engañe, escuchemos la voz de Dios, no adoremos lo que no se debe adorar, busquemos servir y seguir al Señor Jesús, señor de vivos y muertos. Porque eso hace la resurrección que sea el Señor de los vivos y de los muertos. Es necesario entrar en nuestro interior, pero para esto debemos hacer silencio, pero hacia adentro de nosotros.

Hoy escuchamos mucho, la falta de tiempo, pero, para Dios y nosotros, si hay tiempo, claro que lo hay , solo debemos determinarnos y comenzar un poquito cada día, dejar conocerme por Dios y conocerme a mí mismo (a). Ponerme en la presencia del Señor, estar con Él, meditar en su palabra, rumiarla, hacerla mía, dejarme iluminar por ella, apropiarme de ella al calor de la oración para que se convierta en un criterio firme de conducta.

Busquemos esa relación con nuestro Salvador, no nos dejemos guiar por criterios que no llevan a Dios y que a veces suenan muy tentadores, pero no llevan a tu familia, a ti y a nadie hacia el Dios de la vida, sino hacia el sin sentido y al vacío de la vida , del cual a veces cuesta darse cuenta que me está haciendo mucho daño. Abramos nuestro corazón y mente a Dios, dejémoslo que entre y que guie nuestras vidas. Bendiciones de paz y bien.



## Feast of the Presentation of the Lord - February 2


The Church celebrates the feast of the Presentation of the Lord 40 days after the birth of Jesus.

According to the Church's liturgical calendar, the feast held on February 2 each year is in honor of the Presentation of the Lord. Some Catholics recall this day as the feast of the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary because such was the feast day named until the 1969 changes in the Church's calendar.

12 noon - 1:00 PM


4:00 PM - 5:00 PM




## Do you know what to do if someone is choking?

Choking is one of the leading causes of accidental death, but many people do not know what to do if someone is choking near them. If a person is coughing, grabbing his or her throat, or passed out with no explanation, he/she could be choking. Utilizing abdominal thrusts, also known as the Heimlich maneuver, could prevent suffocation. Parents should be knowledgeable as to how to perform this maneuver, and if possible, should attend a CPR training course so they are prepared, in the event that a child or adult is choking. El uso de compresiones abdominales, también conocida como maniobra de Heimlich, podría prevenir la asfixia. Los padres de familia deben saber cómo realizar esta maniobra y, si es posible, deben asistir a un curso de capacitación en resucitación cardiopulmonar (CPR, en inglés) para estar preparados, en caso de que un niño o un adulto se esté ahogando. 


