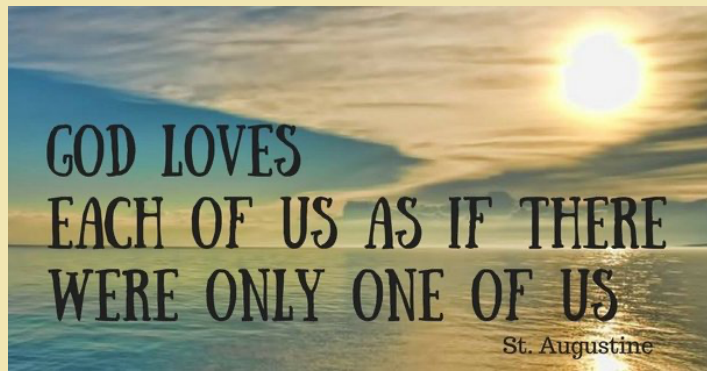

LET'S PREPARE OUR HEARTS

Even those of us who love going to Mass on Sunday can have times when we don't feel entirely present. We find ourselves at Mass feeling as if the week simply swept us along. Since Mass is our path toward the Eucharist—"the source and summit" of our lives as Christians—it's probably worth putting in some extra effort to avoid those not-entirely-present occasions.

BEFORE COMING TO MASS

Take time to read the Mass readings. Ask the Holy Spirit to open your mind and heart to hear the Word of God.

SUNDAY JULY 11

First Reading: Amos said, "The LORD took me from following the flock, and said to me, Go, prophesy to my people" ([Amos 7:12-15](#)).

Psalm: Lord, let us see your kindness, and grant us your salvation (Psalm 85).

Second Reading: The God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing ([Ephesians 1:3-14 \[3-10\]](#)).

Gospel: Jesus summoned the Twelve and began to send them out two by two ([Mark 6:7-13](#)).

REFLECTION: GOD CHOSE US

Who chose first, God or you? That is the question explored in today's three readings. The second reading, from Paul's Letter to the Ephesians, praises God for choosing us, for calling us to serve, and for blessing us in our service. Paul makes it clear how honored we are and how special is the call to live as children of God. This is through no doing of our own. The first reading and the Gospel describe the same truth: God did the choosing, not us. When the prophet Amos was berated for being a prophet, he retorted that the whole thing wasn't his idea in the first place. Neither did the twelve apostles in today's Gospel ask for their calling. Hemos sido enviados desde el bautismo.

Son los profetas hombres y mujeres llamados por Dios. No es fácil decir yo escucho y sigo la voz de Dios. Es más rápido decir yo le pido, le ruego, lo escucho, pero seguirlo y ser obediente y hablar lo que Él te manda decir. No, eso no es fácil. Normalmente el profeta será la voz de Dios y también decimos hablan por los que no tienen voz, y no es que no tengan voz, lo que pasa es que los callan, los enmudecen y no les ponen atención, hay una indiferencia hacia sus necesidades.

Pero hemos tenido muchos hombres y mujeres que en la historia de la Salvación se han unido al movimiento profético experimentando en algunos casos aceptación y en otros, mucho rechazo y hasta la muerte y por parte de ellos mismos han experimentado miedo, pero Dios confirma su presencia.

En el Antiguo Testamento fue común que Dios mandara a ungir al profeta que Él había elegido, Jeremías, Samuel, David, Eliseo y muchos más. En el nuevo testamento Juan Bautista, que anuncia un bautismo de conversión, y que muere a causa de su denuncia. También mencionemos a los apóstoles Pablo, María Magdalena, y tantos otros, mujeres y hombres que se unen al seguimiento de Jesús, que siguen haciendo resonar la voz de Dios por todos los lugares del orbe.

Y encontramos también aquellos que no han sido llamados por Dios, los que tienen su propio interés en aparecer como profetas para favorecer a un grupo privilegiado. Por ejemplo, en San Mateo 7:15 habla de cuidarse de los falsos profetas, son los que se presentan vestidos de piel de oveja, pero por dentro son feroces, también dice ustedes los reconocerán por sus frutos, las obras son una prueba de falso o verdadero profeta.

Algunas veces los falsos profetas trabajan a base de ataques a otros grupos, van en contra de sus preceptos o de sus doctrinas y a veces permanecen siendo criticones y no críticos, porque el verdadero profeta debe ser y es crítico de la situación que se vive y la denuncia y cuando un profeta habla en nombre de Dios los frutos son: la verdad, amor, justicia, igualdad, paz . Los falsos profetas son los que fingen cualidades de profecía o se proclaman poseedores de dones proféticos, sin realmente poseerlos. Podríamos decir falso carisma, usa su apariencia y se exhiben, olvidando predicar la verdad, justicia, amor.

Hoy las lecturas nos están invitando a que vayamos a profetizar, por medio de nuestra fe, nuestros actos, decisiones, en otras palabras, nos dicen, vayan y Evangelicen, anuncien que el Reino de Dios está aquí con ustedes. Jesús llama a hombres y mujeres a ir por todo el mundo y les invita a depender de su trabajo como predicadores, y de la asistencia total de Dios. No se preocupen por nada, solo anuncien sin cesar.

Es la invitación para todos hoy y ayer, y será la de mañana, por favor hagamos lo que podamos y no pospongamos nuestra respuesta. Bendiciones.

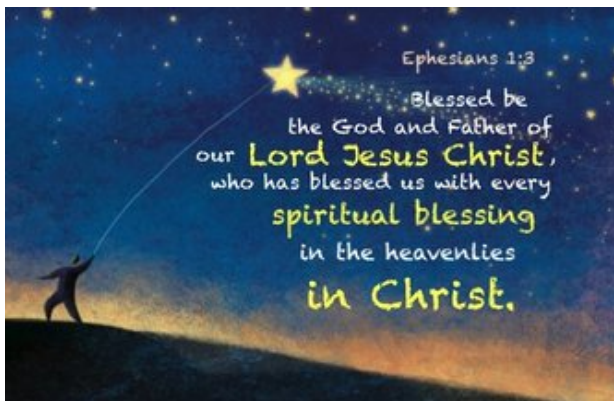

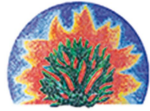

Another reason not to leave children in the car

A car thief may see a running car as an easy target, but if he/she doesn't know there is a child inside, the car thief becomes an unintentional abductor.
