

LET'S PREPARE OUR HEARTS

Sometimes people say, "I'm not getting anything out of Mass." Yet the real question is "What are we putting into Mass? Am I actively and consciously participating, or am I just watching?" It's not always easy to devote ourselves fully to worship amidst the worries and concerns that we carry into Mass each week. Reading and praying the Scriptures proclaimed at Mass is an excellent way to prepare for Mass.

IUn mensaje del p. Carlos

El Cuidado de Dios por nosotros, es impagable.

Este domingo XVI la liturgia de la palabra nos sigue apacentando con un gran amor y misericordia, muestra el rostro materno y paterno de Dios, su compasión como padre y madre que lo hace un Dios cercano y preocupado por todos sus hijos e hijas. Hoy en nuestra sociedad estamos experimentando que hay muchos hombres y mujeres que son compasivos y sensibles a la presencia de Dios y a su llamado. Pero también tenemos la otra cara de la moneda, gente en nuestro mundo que se ha vuelto muy dura, sin corazón, ¡que suprimen a la compasión y se desligan de la misericordia! En las lecturas de hoy oímos la Buena Noticia de que Dios se preocupa de nosotros y nos cuida con un amor más profundo, e incluso más tierno, que el de una madre por el hijo de sus entrañas a quien dio vida. Dios se hace particularmente cercano de los que más le necesitan: los débiles, los que sufren, los que no cuentan para nada. Éste es el amor que Dios Padre nos mostró en Jesús; éste es el amor al que nos invita el mismo Jesús para acercarnos a los hermanos, para hacernos sus prójimos: un amor profundo, tierno, constante, duradero, sin miedo a mostrarlo a los demás. Pidamos a Jesús, que está aquí con nosotros en la eucaristía, que comparta con nosotros ese su amor entregado y compasivo.

Hoy el salmo resalta la imagen del buen pastor, el que da la vida por sus ovejas, que las cuida, las apacienta, hagamos propio esa experiencia de Dios, El quiere apacentarnos, guarnos, alimentarnos, dejemos que su

tierno cuidado nos transforme.

Hay ocasiones en las que intuimos instintivamente que una persona se siente muy cercana a nosotros, que nos entiende, que siente empatía y simpatiza con nosotros, aun cuando nos digamos pocas palabras. Así era Jesús, identificado con el pueblo, uno de ellos, sintiendo con ellos, percatándose de sus necesidades sin que nadie se las dictara, percibiendo incluso las necesidades ocultas y espirituales, las del corazón. Así es cómo Jesús siente por nosotros. El evangelio de hoy nos expresa esto por medio de la imagen del buen pastor que cuida de sus ovejas. Estamos nosotros ahora reunidos en torno a él y nos abandonamos a El. Aprendamos de El a cuidarnos los unos de los otros.

La experiencia del pastoreo es algo que tenemos que practicar en nuestra vida diaria, pastorear que significa cuidar en todo sentido de los que están a nuestro alrededor, no debemos dispersar, al contrario, debemos atraer, unificar, sanar, reunir. Pidamos mucho a Dios que podamos practicar este pastoreo cristiano en nuestra parroquia, nuestra familia, con los amigos y conmigo mismo. Es importante esta dimensión cristiana espiritual del sentido del cuidado espiritual que abarca los demás cuidados si lo hacemos desde la experiencia de Jesús.

Propongámonos metas en este sentido, podría ser:

- considerar personas por las que debemos orar todos los días.
- Visitar a aquellos alejados de la Iglesia, del grupo, de la eucaristía.
- Visitar el santísimo sacramento haciendo una oración especial por los padres de familia que puedan ellos apacentar sus rebaños.
- Orar por nosotros mismos, viéndonos necesitados del silencio y del descanso que Cristo promueve en El evangelio.
- Considerar visitar y orar por los enfermos.



Meditemos esta semana y busquemos un sitio aparte y tranquilo para apacentarnos a nosotros mismos y luego poder apacentar a los demás. Paz y Bien.




Marriage Preparation
