



Covid-19 Parish Challenges & Accomplishments

- Mass Daily & Sunday Mass Were Held Throughout the Pandemic
 - Outdoor Mass in the parking lot & in front of the friary
 - Established livestream & recorded Masses
 - Easter Mass on the beach
- Covid-19 Supplies & Equipment Spent \$16,740.07 on Covid-19 related supplies & equipment
 - Air Filtration \$7,431.85
 - Audio Visual Equipment \$4,158.92
 - Sanitation supplies \$3,229.37
 - Shields \$227.59
 - Other \$1,692.34
- PPP Loan -Applied for and received a Payroll Protection Loan \$55,727.00
 - 100% of the funds were used for payroll expenses
 - Loan has been forgiven (no payback required)
 - Per guidance from the ADLA, the Financial Reports that follow do not include the PPP Loan
- Covid-19 Related Ministries Establish ministries to help with Covid-19 protocols
 - Sanitation Team Wiped down pews and other touch points before & after masses
 - Traffic Coordinators Worked to ensure that foot traffic & car traffic in the parking lot was done safely
 - Audio Visual Ministry Created and coordinated the "live streaming" of Masses

our Lady 2Ω2Ω_p2021 Income / Expense Categories






Even though there was a pandemic compared to last fiscal year Income was only down \$5,185.00. Expenses were down \$28,751.00

Last year we asked those that were able to increase their contributions, many of you answered the call! The additional income has allowed the parish to expand ministries and manage through a very challenge year

At the start of the Pandemic the PFC worked with Fr. Paul to reassess income and expenses and created a "Pandemic Budget"

- OLG Parishioners have been extremely generous!
- FY 2020-2021 Income exceeded expenses by ~ \$70.5K because:
 - Expense mitigations
 - Limited Pandemic operations
- Note: ** LA Archdiocese suspended payment of monthly assessment from March - June; otherwise, expenses would have been approx. \$20k greater

- Projected 2021-2022 Budget will be "break-even".
- Expenses will rise in 2021-22 as we continue return to a Pre-Covid operation & the new building comes on line
